RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY ATTORNEY TO COMPROMISE AND SETTLE THE CASE OF PATRICA HARPER v. CITY OF OAKLAND, ALAMEDA COUNTY SUPERIOR COURT CASE NO. RG10-535800, IN THE AMOUNT OF EIGHTEEN THOUSAND DOLLARS AND NO CENTS (\$18,000.00) AS A RESULT OF A TRIP AND FALL ACCIDENT ON THIRD STREET NEAR ADELINE & MAGNOLIA STREET ON MAY 16, 2009 (PUBLIC WORKS AGENCY)

WHEREAS: Patricia Harper was injured when she tripped and fell in an open tree well within the sidewalk; and

WHEREAS: Ms. Harper sustained serious injuries requiring medical treatment as a result of this accident; and

WHEREAS: In order to avoid the risk of an adverse jury verdict under the circumstances;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED: That the City Attorney is authorized and directed to compromise and settle the case of <u>Patrica Harper v. City of Oakland</u>, City Attorney's File No. 27308, for the sum of Eighteen Thousand Dollars and No Cents (\$18,000.00); and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Attorney is further authorized and directed to take whatever steps as may be necessary to effect said settlement; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the sum of Eighteen Thousand Dollars and No Cents (\$18,000.00) be payable to Plaintiff Patricia Harper and Michael I. Dorshkind, her attorney.
