Ordinance Amending Ordinance Number 12525 C.M.S. (Master Fee Schedule),

as Amended, to Establish, Modify, and Delete Fees Assessed by Selected Offices,

Departments, and Agencies of the City of Oakland

### Summary

The attached ordinance amends Ordinance Number 12525 C.M.S. (the Master Fee Schedule, or "MFS"), to establish, modify and delete fees assessed by the Office of the City Administrator, Office of the City Clerk, Finance and Management Agency, Office of Parks and Recreation, Department of Human Services, Oakland Public Library, Cultural Arts and Marketing, Police Services Agency, Fire Services Agency, Public Works Agency, and Community and Economic Development Agency. In most cases, changes to fees are required to offset increases in costs related to the provision of services for which fees are charged, and/or to better reflect the predominant market fees and demand. Detailed explanations/justifications for fee changes are provided in the "Discussion" section below.

A public hearing has been scheduled to review the proposed fee changes. The meeting will take place at the time of the first reading of the proposed ordinance by the Council, on June 10, 2004, at 5:00pm or as soon as practically possible thereafter.

#### **Fiscal Impact**

The revenue increases from the proposed Master Fee Schedule changes will offset increases in costs to provide services for which the increased fees are charged, with no net gain. Both revenue and cost increases have been included in the City's FY 2004-05 Midcycle Revised budget.

#### Discussion

Two attachments are presented with this agenda report. Attachment A shows proposed changes to the Master Fee Schedule for City Council adoption. Attachment B reflects changes already adopted by the City Council, but not yet reflected in the published Master Fee Schedule document, because they were approved after the previous annual document (FY 2003-04) had been published. Examples of such changes include the series of fees and civil penalties proposed by the Office of the City Administrator's Nuisance Enforcement Unit and the new fees for Medical Cannabis Dispensary Permits adopted by Council on February 17, 2004.

The Master Fee Schedule changes not yet approved by the City Council, and presented in Attachment A, are summarized below.

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### 1. Office of the City Administrator - Budget Office

• The Budget Office is proposing to increase fees for the "Budget in Brief" and "Five-Year Capital Improvement Program" publications, and to add fees for the "Oakland Redevelopment Agency Budget" and "Five-Year Financial Forecast" publications. These fees reflect the actual cost of printing the documents. No significant changes in revenues are anticipated from these fee modifications.

#### 2. City Clerk

- The Office of the City Clerk is proposing to add a new "Programming or Computer Service" fee to recoup staffing costs of providing such service. The anticipated annual revenue of \$500 will accrue to the General Purpose Fund (GPF), and has been included in the FY 2004-05 Midcycle Revised budget.
- In addition, a new "Passport Photo" fee is being added to provide a one-stop shop for passport customers. The \$8.00 fee is comparable with fees among other vendors providing such service. The estimated additional revenue is negligible.

#### 3. Community and Economic Development Agency

The Community and Economic Development Agency (CEDA) is proposing a number of fee changes. These are summarized below, by category. All additional revenues will accrue to the General Purpose Fund, except as indicated below, and will cover increases in costs to provide associated services. Both revenue and cost increases are reflected in the FY 2004-05 Mid-cycle budget.

- Building Services Administration
  - A. New fees are proposed for: i) processing of building dispute, and ii) collection of security deposits for development and code enforcement projects. The fees will cover actual costs of services.
  - B. In addition, changes are proposed to titles of two existing fees, with no modifications to the fees themselves.
- Building Services Code Compliance
  - A. New fees are proposed for: i) parcel compliance plans; ii) permits to legalize illegal vehicular food vendors; and iii) processing unfounded code compliance violation appeals. The fees will cover actual costs of services.
  - B. In addition, a title of an existing fee is being changed, with no modifications to the fee itself.
- Building Services Engineering
  - A. A new fee is proposed for a permit to legalize an illegal encroachment. The fee will cover actual costs of services.
  - B. Increases are proposed to existing fees for: i) construction site monitoring; and ii) obstruction permits. The increased fees reflect actual costs of services.

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C. In addition, changes are proposed to titles of three existing fees, with no modifications to the fees themselves.

#### Building Services – Inspection

- A. New fees are proposed for: i) inspection of low voltage systems, and ii) certificates of occupancy related to construction permits. The fees will cover actual costs of services.
- B. A correction is being made to the title covering plan checking fees for electrical, plumbing low voltage systems, or mechanical permits. The commercial fee within this category is also being corrected.
- C. In addition, a title is being changed for the existing fee for inspection of fixtures and waste devices, with no modifications to the fee itself.

#### Building Services – Plan Check

- A. New fees are proposed for: i) requests (in excess of two) for alternate materials or method of construction, for Grades II and III, ii) plan checking and/or processing of application for a permit required by Oakland Zoning or subdivision regulations, or environmental review, and iii) a standard zoning conformation letter. The fees will cover actual costs of services.
- B. Increases are proposed to existing fees for: i) requests (first two) for alternate materials or method of construction, for Grades II and III, ii) plan check and inspection for site development not related to any other required permit; iii) applications under the Oakland Zoning Regulations section 42511 (including major conditional use permit, major variance, special residential design review, requests for extension and CPC reconsideration, and business tax certificate), iv) requests for environmental impact assessment, and v) written determination by zooming administrator.
- C. In addition, changes are proposed to titles of a number of existing fees, with no modifications to the fees themselves.

#### Miscellaneous – Real Estate

A new Telecommunication Administration Fee is proposed, to cover administrative costs associated with requests from telecommunication and wireless providers for use of city property. No significant changes in revenues are anticipated from these fee modifications.

#### Miscellaneous – Residential Rent Adjustment

Fees requested for deletion relate to appeals of residential rent adjustment decisions; these fees have been replaced by the rent program service fees. Additional fees to cover the costs of copying meeting materials and producing audio records are requested as well. No significant changes in revenues are anticipated from these fee modifications.

### Miscellaneous – Workforce Development

A new \$30 fee is proposed for the Enterprise Zone Hiring Tax Credit Voucher, with the intent of defraying the costs to process vouchers and promoting the Enterprise

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Zone Hiring Tax Credit and other workforce development services to Oakland employers. The estimated additional revenue of \$375,000 will accrue to the Workforce Investment Act (2195) fund, and has been included in the FY 2004-05 Midcycle Revised budget.

#### • Planning & Zoning

- A. Increases are proposed to application fees under the Oakland Zoning Regulations, to reflect actual costs of services.
- B. Increases to fees are proposed for environmental review of non-exempt projects, to reflect actual costs of services.
- C. A new fee is proposed for environmental review of projects exempt under California Code sections 15280 or 15332, or for other exemptions requiring findings. The fee will cover actual costs of services.
- D. Increases to Mitigation Monitoring fees are proposed, to reflect actual costs of services.
- E. Increases are proposed to fees for Consultation Services or Preliminary Plan Review of regular projects, to reflect actual costs of services.
- F. A new fee is proposed for Consultation Services or Preliminary Plan Review of major projects.
- G. A new Zoning Confirmation Letter fee is proposed, to cover actual costs of services.

#### 4. Cultural Arts and Marketing

The Cultural Arts and Marketing Agency (CAM) is proposing a number of fee changes. These are summarized below, by category.

#### • Alice Arts Center

Modifications are proposed to fees for the Main Stage/Theater, Studio A, Studios B and D, and Studio C. The fee changes (both increases and decreases) are intended to reflect predominant market rates, and to cover (partially or fully) actual costs to service these facilities. The estimated additional revenue is negligible.

### • KTOP & Film Office

A number of new fees are proposed for production services and film permits. In addition, an increase is proposed to film permit fee for commercial advertising production. The new fees (as well as the proposed change) are intended to reflect predominant market rates, and to cover (partially or fully) actual costs to provide services. The estimated additional revenue of \$47,000 will accrue to the General Purpose F und (GPF), and has been included in the FY 2004-05 M idcycle R evised budget.

#### 5. Finance and Management

• The Finance and Management Agency (FMA) is proposing: i) a new administrative fee for promissory notes, ii) a new fee for business tax certificate reports, iii) a new

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fee for a compact-disk version of CAFR, and iv) increases to the existing fees for CAFT (hard copy) and miscellaneous financial reports. The fees will cover actual costs of producing documents and/or providing services. The estimated additional revenue of \$1,500 will accrue to the General Purpose Fund (GPF), and has been included in the FY 2004-05 Midcycle Revised budget.

• FMA is proposing to transfer the Alcoholic Beverage Retail Establishment Fee to the Police Services Agency (which now administers the program). PSA, in addition to accepting the transfer, is proposing an increase to the existing fee, as reflected in the "Police Services Agency" section below.

#### 6. Fire Services

- The Fire Services Agency is proposing to increase their fees by 5.0 percent across the board, to reflect increased costs to provide services (driven by CPI and MOU increases).
- New fees are proposed for: i) permits required by the Oakland Fire Code (for aerosol products, asbestos removal, battery systems, carnivals and fairs, cellulose nitrate film storage, liquid gas fueled vehicle/equipment in assembly area, motor vehicle dispensing stations, pyrotechnics/special events, tire storage, wood products, and welding/hot-works), ii) inspections for fire clearance (for large family day care), and iii) hazardous materials management plans (for spills, leaks and contaminated sites). The new fees will offset the cost of providing services.
- In addition, recommended for deletion are three specific fees for the annual renewal of permits required by the Oakland Fire Code. No significant fiscal impact is projected from these changes.

#### 7. Human Services

• The Department of Human Services is proposing to establish a new, \$20 fee for kitchen use in the Senior Centers. The estimated additional revenue of \$8,640 will accrue to the General Purpose Fund (GPF), and has been included in the FY 2004-05 Midcycle Revised budget.

#### 8. Parks and Recreation

The Office of Parks and Recreation (OPR) is proposing to increase the following fees: i) admission and parking charges at the Oakland Zoo at Knowland Park (these are charged directly by the zoo operator), ii) various park use permits, including permits for picnics and regular events, permits for events at Redwood Heights and Montclair, cancellations of special events and events at the Lakeside Park Bandstand; iii) rentals of and deposits for indoor facilities; iv) rentals of Woodminster Amphitheater by Oakland residents and Oakland-based non-profits; v) commercial rentals of outdoor facilities for major feature production; vi) alcohol and sound permits; vii) permit-related administrative service fees; viii) fees for boat rentals, boating classes, and s wimming pool reservations; ix) v arious camp fees (including basic, reservation and lodging/meals); and x) stall and paddock charges at the Oakland Stables (these are charged directly by the operator). The fee increases will

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help to offset rising costs of providing services. Of the estimated additional revenue of \$9,590, \$8,960 will accrue to the General Purpose Fund (GPF) and \$630 will accrue to Fund 7999 (Miscellaneous Trusts), and has been included in the FY 2004-05 Midcycle Revised budget.

- The OPR is also proposing to add new fees for: i) park use permits for regular events, for residents (500 and above, as well as a holiday surcharge) and non-residents (any number of patrons and a holiday surcharge), ii) park use permits for the Joaquin Miller Park; iii) hourly permits rates for non-residents and cancellation fees for residents at the Lakeside Park Bandstand; iii) rentals of various indoor facilities by non-Oakland based non-profits; iv) various indoor facilities that are rented without room; v) rentals at the Joaquin Miller Conference Center, Morcom Rose Garden and Japanese Garden; vi) rentals of Woodminster Amphitheater by non-Oakland based non-profits; vii) commercial rentals (including cancellations) of various indoor and outdoor facilities; vii) permit-related staffing fees; viii) reservation deposit and lifeguard services (for parties above 40) for swimming pools; ix) swimming instruction classes for junior lifeguard camp, and various special instructions for non-Oakland residents; and x) class fee discounts for disabled patrons. The new fees will offset the actual costs of providing services. Of the additional revenue from these fees, estimated at \$99,297; \$94,297 will accrue to the General Purpose Fund (GPF) and \$5,000 will accrue to Fund 1820 (OPRCA Self-Sustaining Revolving Fund) and has been included in the FY 2004-05 Midcycle Revised budget.
- The OPR is also proposing to delete a number of fees that are no longer used. No revenue loss is anticipated from these deletions, as the fees are not currently being applied.
- In addition, OPR is revising descriptions of some of their fees, to better reflect the actual services performed.

#### 9. Police Services

- The Police Services Agency (PSA) is proposing to increase the following fees: i) peddler's police certificate; ii) investigation of a petition to seal an arrest records; iii) redemption fees for claiming impounded a nimals and livestock; iv) service fee for treating animals for rabies; v) identification service fee; vi) emergency response charges; vii) vehicle release fees; viii) overtime service fees for parades, special events and short-term encroachment permits; ix) animal vaccinations; and x) STOP vehicle release fees. The fee increases will help to offset rising costs of providing services, but will not impact current General Purpose Fund (GPF) revenue estimates because actual collections have been lower than projected.
- In addition, PSA has concurred with FMA's proposal to transfer the Alcoholic Beverage Retail Establishment Fee from FMA to PSA (who are now administering the program). PSA, in addition to accepting the transfer, is proposing an increase to the existing annual inspection fee from \$600 to \$1,500. The fee increase is to ensure that the ABAT program is self-sustaining (i.e. program revenues equal program costs). The additional annual revenue of approximately \$300,000 will accrue to the General Purpose Fund to offset the ABAT program costs. This change has been reflected in the FY 2004-05 Midcycle Revised budget.

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- The PSA is also proposing to add new fees for: i) neutering or spaying a dog; ii) various false alarm program components; iii) crime analysis; iv) medical procedures at the animal shelter; and v) dog obedience courses. The new fees will offset the actual costs of providing services. The additional revenue from these fees is minimal and will not impact current General Purpose Fund (GPF) revenue estimates.
- The PSA is also proposing to delete a specific false alarm fee for no or inadequate response by an alarm company. No revenue loss is anticipated from this deletion, as the fee is not currently being applied.
- In addition, PSA is revising descriptions of some of their fees, to better reflect the actual services performed.

#### 10. Public Library

- The Oakland Public Library is proposing to increase a library card replacement fee, as a deterrent against card loss and misplacement, and make this fee more comparable with other neighboring cities. The estimated additional revenue of \$4,000 will accrue to the General Purpose Fund (GPF), and has been included in the FY 2004-05 Midcycle Revised budget.
- The Library is also proposing to add new fees for: i) microform copying, ii) computer printing, iii) photo reprinting; iv) interlibrary loan processing, and v) copying / mailing. The new fees will offset the actual costs of providing services. In addition, new fines are proposed for overdue tools borrowed from the Tool Lending Library, and will reflect the actual value of the tools. Of the additional revenue from these changes, estimated at \$14,500; \$4,000 will accrue to the General Purpose Fund (GPF) and \$10,500 will accrue to Fund 7540 (Oakland Public Library Trust) and has been included in the FY 2004-05 Midcycle Revised budget.

#### 11. Public Works

- The Public Works Agency (PWA) is proposing to increase the following fees: i) additional inspection related to excavation permits; ii) regular inspection related to excavation permits for utility companies. The fee increase will help offset the rising costs of providing services. The estimated additional revenue of \$43,050 will accrue to the Sewer Service Fund. The PWA is also proposing to increase the fees for: i) penalty for late payment of monthly parking fees at various City garages; ii) special event parking at various City garages. The fee increases will help to offset rising costs of providing services. The estimated additional revenue is estimated at \$2,000 and will accrue to the Multipurpose Reserve Fund.
- The PWA is proposing to add new fees for: i) hourly parking and monthly parking tag replacement at the 12<sup>th</sup> and Jefferson Street lot; and ii) work for the Technical Review Advisory Committee. The new fees will offset the actual costs of providing services. The additional revenue from these fees is estimated at \$3,000 and will accrue to the Multipurpose Reserve Fund.
- The PWA is also proposing to delete an "early bird special" fee for the Telegraph Parking Plaza garage. No revenue loss is anticipated from this deletion, as the fee is not currently being applied.

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- In addition, PWA is clarifying an hourly rate for traffic engineering analysis and validation fees.
- And lastly, fees associated with the Tree Section, which is being transferred from OPR to PWA, are also being moved to PWA. Some of these fees are also proposed to be changed as follows:
  - An increase is proposed for an appeal of Tree Removal Permits to the City Council, from \$50.00 to \$449.00. The increased fee is anticipated to cover staff time and is consistent with the fee charged by zoning staff for comparable appeals to the City Council for Administrative cases.
  - In addition, a fee for appeals of Tree Removal Permits to the Parks and Recreation Advisory Commission has been added, which will cover costs for non-development related tree permit appeals. This fee had been inadvertently left off the current Master Fee Schedule. This fee is \$50.00 per appeal.

#### Recommendation

Staff recommends that the City Council accept this report and adopt a proposed ordinance amending the Master Fee Schedule, as reflected in <u>Attachment A</u>. Once adopted, the amended fees will become effective on July 1, 2004. A public hearing has been scheduled to review the proposed fee changes. The meeting will take place at the time of the first reading of the proposed ordinance by the Council, on June 10, 2004, at 5:00pm or as soon as practically possible thereafter.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NUMBER 12525 C.M.S. (MASTER FEE SCHEDULE), AS AMENDED, TO ESTABLISH, MODIFY AND DELETE FEES ASSESSED  $\mathbf{B}\mathbf{Y}$ THE OFFICE OF THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR, OFFICE OF THE CITY CLERK, FINANCE AND MANAGEMENT AGENCY, OFFICE OF PARKS AND RECREATION, DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES, OAKLAND PUBLIC LIBRARY, CULTURAL ARTS AND MARKETING, POLICE SERVICES AGENCY, FIRE SERVICES AGENCY, PUBLIC WORKS AGENCY, AND COMMUNITY AND ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT AGENCY

WHEREAS, the City of Oakland periodically updates its Master Fee Schedule to account for general cost of living increases and program changes or other costs; and

WHEREAS, the fee modifications and additions proposed herein have been justified by the respective agencies and are identified in an "Agenda Report" dated June 10, 2004 to Deborah Edgerly, City Administrator, entitled "An Ordinance Amending Ordinance Number 12525 C.M.S. (Master Fee Schedule), as Amended, to Establish, Modify, and Delete Fees Assessed by selected Offices, Departments, and Agencies of the City of Oakland"; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds and determines that the herein-referenced modifications and additions are necessary to reimburse the City for the costs of performing the various municipal and regulatory functions; and

WHEREAS, a Public Hearing was held on June 10, 2004, to review the proposed fee changes;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Oakland does hereby ordain as follows:

Sections 1. The Master Fee Schedule as set forth in Ordinance Number 12525 C.M.S., as amended, is hereby amended to modify and establish fees assessed by the (Agencies/Departments) and as set forth in Exhibit A, attached hereto and made a part hereof.

**Section 2.** This ordinance shall be effective on July 1, 2004 upon approval by the Council of the City of Oakland.
