

**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO 1) ACCEPT AND APPROPRIATE COMMUNITY SERVICES BLOCK GRANT (CSBG) AMERICAN RECOVERY AND REINVESTMENT ACT OF 2009 (ARRA) FUNDING IN THE AMOUNT OF \$1,212,697 FROM THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY SERVICES AND DEVELOPMENT (CSD), CONTRACT NUMBER 09F-5103 TO SUPPORT THE CITY OF OAKLAND COMMUNITY ACTION PARTNERSHIP'S (OCAP) STATE APPROVED CSBG ANTI-POVERTY RECOVERY ACT LOCAL PLAN AND 2) AMEND AND EXECUTE PROFESSIONAL SERVICES CONTRACTS AND GRANT AGREEMENTS WITH CURRENTLY FUNDED AGENCIES TO EXPAND OCAP'S TRAINING, EDUCATION, AND EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITIES FOR OAKLAND'S LOW-INCOME RESIDENTS**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Oakland Community Action Partnership (OCAP) was awarded \$1,212,697 in additional funding from the State Department of Community Service and Development through the Federal Community Service Block Grant (CSBG) American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 to expand OCAP's training, education, and employment opportunities for Oakland's low-income residents; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Oakland Community Action Partnership was required by the State Department of Community Services and Development to submitted, within two weeks, an OCAP CSBG Recovery Act Local Plan by May 11, 2009; and

**WHEREAS**, the Oakland City Council received an update on the proposed OCAP CSBG Recovery Act Local Plan at the May 5, 2009 city council meeting; and

**WHEREAS**, the State of California Department of Community Services and Development has issued a fifteen month contract (July 1, 2009 through September 30, 2010) to the Oakland Community Action Partnership through Contract Number 09F-5103; and

**WHEREAS**, due to the State of California budget stalemate, the current execution date of the CSBG ARRA contract is scheduled for December 1, 2009; and

**WHEREAS**, the Oakland City Council previously approved Resolution Number 81106 to accept " any additional CSBG funding that may become available without returning to council" for calendar years 2008 and 2009; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Oakland Community Action Partnership was notified by the State Department of Community Services and Development on November 04, 2009 that a “resolution specific to the CSBG ARRA agreement” is required to authorize the execution of the City of Oakland’s CSBG ARRA contract; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Oakland, on behalf of OCAP and its federally mandated administering board, is willing to accept and appropriate the aforementioned grant in the amount of \$1,212,697 and offset city revenues in the amount of \$1,212,697 for the contracted period of July 1, 2009 through September 30, 2010, under provisions of the ARRA Community Services Block Grant; and

**WHEREAS**, these funds will be used to provide training, education, an employment services to Oakland’s low-income citizens to help them become self sufficient and address Oakland’s unemployment rate of 17% as of September 2009; and

**WHEREAS**, Oakland’s Community Action Partnership would like to amend professional services contracts and grant agreements with currently funded agencies to expand OCAP’s training, education, and employment opportunities for Oakland’s low-income residents with the following anti-poverty service providers who have previously competed in a competitive bid process; and

**WHEREAS**, OCAP will allocate \$130,697 to cover the cost of administration, staffing, and training; and

**WHEREAS**, due to the grantor’s imposed 12% total administrative cap for the agency and its subcontracts, OCAP request a wavier of central services overhead charges; now, therefore, be it

**RESOLVED:** That the City Administrator or his designee is hereby authorized to accept and appropriate Community Services Block Grant (CSBG) American Recovery And Reinvestment Act Of 2009 (ARRA) Funding in the amount of \$1,212,697 from the State of California Department of Community Services and Development (CSD), Contract Number 09F-5103 to support the City Of Oakland Community Action Partnership's (OCAP) State Approved CSBG Anti-Poverty Recovery Act Local Plan and offset city revenues in the aforementioned amount for the purpose described above; and be it

**FURTHER RESOLVED:** That the City Council hereby authorizes the City Administrator or his designee as an agent for the City to amend and execute professional services contracts and grant agreements with the aforementioned agencies and submit all documents, including but not limited to applications, agreements, amendments, modifications, payment requests, terminations and related actions which may be necessary; and be it

**FURTHER RESOLVED:** That said grant agreements shall be approved as to form and legality by the Office of the City Attorney and placed on file in the Office of the City Clerk.


