**RESOLUTION ELECTING COUNCILMEMBER _____ AS
PRESIDENT PRO TEMPORE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
OAKLAND FOR THE TERM ENDING JANUARY 4, 2027 PURSUANT TO
OAKLAND CITY CHARTER SECTION 208**

WHEREAS, the Charter section 208 provides in relevant part: "At 11:00 a.m. on the first Monday following January 2 following each General Municipal Election, the Council shall meet at the established Council meeting place, at which time and place the newly elected members of the Council shall assume the duties of their office; and at such meeting, and at its first meeting in January of each odd-numbered year, the Council shall, by resolution, elect a Council President from among its members to serve for a two-year term. The Council also shall elect, by resolution, a President Pro Tempore of the Council from among its members to serve a one or two-year term"; and

WHEREAS, Rule 6 of the Council Rules of Procedure, established by Resolution No. 90066 C.M.S., provides that "[i]n the absence or unavailability of the President of the Council, the President Pro Tempore shall perform the duties of the President of the Council"; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED: That Councilmember _____ is elected President Pro Tempore of the City Council of the City of Oakland for the term beginning July 2, 2025 and ending January 4, 2027 in accordance with Charter section 208 and Rule 6 of the City Council's Rules of Procedure, established by Resolution No. 90066 C.M.S.
