AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 14.8 OF ORDINANCE NO. 713 C.M.S. TO PROVIDE A \$75.00 MONTHLY INCREASE TO OAKLAND MUNICIPAL EMPLOYEES RETIREMENT SYSTEM (OMERS) RETIREES AND A \$37.50 MONTHLY INCREASE TO OMERS BENEFICIARIES

SUMMARY

An ordinance has been prepared that will amend section 14.8 of Ordinance No. 713 C.M.S., to provide an increase of \$75.00 per month for members of the Oakland Municipal Employees' Retirement System (OMERS) and \$37.50 per month for beneficiaries, pursuant to a unanimous motion of the OMERS Board of Administration.

FISCAL IMPACT

The actuary for OMERS, has estimated the present value cost of the increase(s) to be \$377,000. The OMERS system has sufficient funding to cover this increase. Therefore, no financial support from the City or its general fund is needed to provide the increased benefit to OMERS retirees or beneficiaries.

BACKGROUND

At its regular meeting of May 27, 2004, the OMERS Board of Administration voted unanimously to increase monthly benefit payments for annuitants by \$75.00 and \$37.50 per beneficiary. The purpose of this increase is to provide greater purchasing power to OMERS annuitants and beneficiaries.

OMERS is a local retirement system operated by the City of Oakland that has been closed to new members since 1970. During the 1970's the majority of Oakland's civilian employees, by vote, opted to become members in the Public Employees' Retirement System (PERS). The last remaining employed OMERS member transferred to PERS on June 19, 2004. There are 80 impacted annuitants and beneficiaries receiving pension payments.

The table below outlines the previous benefit increases granted to OMERS members and beneficiaries:

KEY IMPACTS

The projected total cost associated with the proposed increase (\$75.00 per member and \$37.50 per beneficiary) will cost approximately \$377,000. The City will not have to use general fund revenues to pay for the proposed increase in benefits payments, as the plan's funds are sufficient to pay all costs associated with this increase.

RECOMMENDATION AND RATIONALE

Staff recommends the approval of this ordinance amending Ordinance 713 C.M.S. The approval of this ordinance will provide additional monthly benefits to OMERS annuitants and beneficiaries with minimal financial impact on the systems portfolio.

WHEREAS, the Board of Administration for the Oakland Municipal Employees' Retirement System (OMERS) requests that the City Council approve a one-time increase to the retirees and beneficiaries of the OMERS retirement plan; and

WHEREAS, the OMERS Board of Administration unanimously voted to increase monthly payments for its plan members; and

WHEREAS, said increase shall be in the amount of \$75.00 per month for retirees and \$37.50 per month for beneficiaries; now therefore

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OAKLAND DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 14.8 of Ordinance No. 713 C.M.S. is hereby amended as follows:

This benefit is to provide an increase to the monthly retirement allowance for OMERS retirees and beneficiaries. The conditions of this increase are as follows:

- (1) Every retired member's monthly retirement allowance payable by the Retirement System shall be increased by the amount of \$75.00 per month.
- (2) Every Beneficiary's monthly retirement allowance payable by the Retirement System shall be increased by the amount of \$37.50 per month.
- (3) The increase shall be paid in addition to the regular 3% Cost-of-Living Adjustment given on July 1, 2004.
- (4) The effective date of this increase is July 1, 2004.

The increase in retirement allowance provided for herein shall not be provided nor paid to the following persons:

(1) Former employees of the City of Oakland transferred to the County of Alameda effective July 1, 1957.
