RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING IMMEDIATE ALLOCATION IN THE AMOUNT OF \$125,000 FROM PRIORITY PROJECT FUNDS OF OAKLAND MAYOR JERRY BROWN TO INFRASTRUCTURE IMPROVEMENTS AT OAKLAND'S LONGFELLOW ELEMENTARY SCHOOL

WHEREAS, on June 8, 2006 the City Council amended the 2005-2007 Policy Budget for the City of Oakland to allocate \$250,000 for each Councilmember for priority projects in the Councilmembers' neighborhoods, subject to City Council approval; and

WHEREAS, the Council allocated \$125,000 of priority project funds to Mayor Jerry Brown, subject to City Council approval; and

WHEREAS, Longfellow Elementary School was built in the 1950's and is in need of crucial renovations and repairs; and

WHEREAS, Longfellow Elementary was built to serve 400 students and needs additional infrastructure to house a larger student population; and

WHEREAS, general repairs and renovation of the existing school include but are not limited to: replacement of toilets and sinks, multiple windows, damaged ceiling tiles, fixtures, lighting, and the addition of science labs and a gymnasium; and

WHEREAS, the Oakland Military Institute (OMI) must leave its current site no later than June 1, 2007 and the Oakland Public School District has offered OMI a ten-year lease for the currently empty Longfellow Elementary School on condition of infrastructure and site improvements; now, therefore be it

**RESOLVED:** That \$125,000 from the priority project funds of Mayor Jerry Brown be appropriated for the purpose of site renovation and infrastructure improvements at Oakland's Longfellow Elementary School.
