**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO ENTER INTO OR AMEND CONTRACTS WITH WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT PROVIDERS TO PROVIDE COMPREHENSIVE CAREER SERVICES TO YOUTH, THE UNHOUSED, AND THE FORMERLY INCARCERATED RESIDING IN THE FLATLANDS NEIGHBORHOODS BELOW INTERSTATE-580 (FRUITVALE, CHINATOWN, EAST OAKLAND, WEST OAKLAND) FOR AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$500,000 AS FOLLOWS:**

- (1) LAO FAMILY COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT IN THE ADDITIONAL AMOUNT OF \$62,500;**
- (2) THE UNITY COUNCIL IN THE ADDITIONAL AMOUNT OF \$62,500;**
- (3) YOUTH EMPLOYMENT PARTNERSHIP IN THE ADDITIONAL AMOUNT OF \$25,000;**
- (4) CIVICORPS IN THE ADDITIONAL AMOUNT OF \$125,000;**
- (5) EAST BAY ASIAN YOUTH CENTER IN THE AMOUNT OF \$75,000;**
- (6) YOUTH UPRISING IN THE AMOUNT OF \$75,000; AND**
- (7) WEST OAKLAND JOB RESOURCE CENTER IN THE AMOUNT OF \$75,000.**

**WHEREAS**, at a special meeting on July 26, 2021, the Oakland City Council adopted Resolution No. 88784 C.M.S. which, among other things, amends the City's fiscal year (FY) 2021-23 biennial budget to include a general fund allocation in FY 2021-22 to the Oakland Workforce Development division of \$1,510,000; and

**WHEREAS**, Council directed \$1,010,000 of said funds to Lao Family Community Development in the amount of \$175,000, Oakland Private Industry Council in the amount of \$260,000, The Unity Council in the amount of \$175,000, Youth Employment Partnership in the amount of \$175,000, Civicorps in the amount of \$75,000, Rising Sun Center for Opportunity in the amount of \$75,000, and Cypress Mandela in the amount of \$75,000; and

**WHEREAS**, Council provided budget authorization for job readiness, placement grants/contracts in the amount of \$500,000, of said funds, with a "Focus on flatlands

neighborhoods below 580 - Fruitvale, Chinatown, East Oakland, West Oakland - and impacted communities including youth, homeless and formerly incarcerated”; and

**WHEREAS**, at a meeting on August 5, 2021, the Oakland Workforce Development Board accepted the \$1,510,000 in additional general fund support; and

**WHEREAS**, subsequently, at a special meeting on September 17, 2021, the Oakland Workforce Development Board approved the Council directed appropriation of \$1,010,000 in additional general fund support to Lao Family Community Development in the amount of \$175,000, Oakland Private Industry Council in the amount of \$260,000, The Unity Council in the amount of \$175,000 , Youth Employment Partnership in the amount of \$175,000, Civicorps in the amount of \$75,000, Rising Sun Center for Opportunity in the amount of \$75,000, and Cypress Mandela in the amount of \$75,000; and

**WHEREAS**, at the same special meeting on September 17, 2021, the Oakland Workforce Development Board also approved an additional \$500,000 in discretionary general fund to focus on flatlands neighborhoods below I-580 and provide support to Lao Family Community Development in the amount of \$62,500, The Unity Council in the amount of \$62,500, Youth Employment Partnership in the amount of \$25,000, Civicorps in the amount of \$125,000, East Bay Asian Youth Center in the amount of \$75,000, Youth Uprising in the amount of \$75,000, West Oakland Job Resource Center in the amount of \$75,000; and

**WHEREAS**, the total general fund amount approved for FY 2021-22 workforce service providers are below; now, therefore be it,

**RESOLVED:** That the City Administrator or his designee is hereby authorized to enter into or amend contracts with workforce development providers to provide comprehensive career services to youth, the unhoused, and the formerly incarcerated residing in the flatlands

neighborhoods below I-580 (Fruitvale, Chinatown, East Oakland, West Oakland) for an amount not to exceed \$500,000 as follows:

- (1) Lao Family Community Development in the additional amount of \$62,500;
- (2) The Unity Council in the additional amount of \$62,500;
- (3) Youth Employment Partnership in the additional amount of \$25,000;
- (4) Civicorps in the additional amount of \$125,000;
- (5) East Bay Asian Youth Center in the amount of \$75,000;
- (6) Youth Uprising in the amount of \$75,000; and
- (7) West Oakland Job Resource Center in the amount of \$75,000; and be it

**FURTHER RESOLVED:** That the City Administrator is hereby authorized to enter into the grant agreements with the authorized workforce development providers and in the amounts identified herein for an additional amount of \$500,000 from the General Purpose Fund (1010), Workforce Development Organization (85311), Workforce Development Services Project (1006028), Workforce Development Program (SC03); and be it

**FURTHER RESOLVED:** That the City Administrator is hereby authorized to spend funds in FY 2021-22 and take other action with respect to the adopted budget and authorized contracts consistent with the Resolution and its basic purposes.
