INTRODUCED BY MAYOR LIBBY SCHAAF

RESOLUTION CONFIRMING THE REAPPOINTMENT OF TIYANNA LONG AND THE APPOINTMENT OF TRACEY CORDER AS MEMBERS OF THE CANNABIS REGULATORY COMMISSION

WHEREAS, Section 601 of the City Charter provides that members of City boards and commissions shall be appointed by the Mayor subject to confirmation by the affirmative vote of five members of the City Council; and

WHEREAS, the Oakland Cannabis Regulation and Revenue Act (Ordinance number 12694 C.M.S.), also known as Measure Z (Ordinance), adopted by the voters of Oakland, November 2, 2004, in the General Municipal Election, formed the Cannabis Regulatory Commission to oversee the Ordinance's implementation and to make recommendations to the City Council regarding the licensure, taxation, and regulation of cannabis for adult use; and

WHEREAS, the Oakland Cannabis Regulation and Revenue Act specifies that members of the Cannabis Regulatory Commission are to be appointed one by the Mayor, one by the City Auditor, one by the City Administrator, and one from each Member of the City Council, to serve unlimited two-year terms; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable Mayor Libby Schaaf has reappointed **Tiyanna Long** and has appointed **Tracey Corder** to serve two-year terms subject to confirmation by the City Council; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED: That pursuant to City Charter section 601, the City Council confirms these mayoral appointments as follows:

- 1) **Tiyanna Long** is reappointed to the Cannabis Regulatory Commission as the City Auditor's Representative for the term beginning August 1, 2020 and will end July 31, 2022, filling the seat previously held by herself; and
- 2) **Tracey Corder** is appointed to the Cannabis Regulatory Commission as the District Two Representative for the term beginning August 1, 2020 and will end July 31, 2022, filling the seat previously held by Chang R. Yi.
