Construction Contract To McGuire & Hester For The Alameda Avenue, Oakland Waterfront Bay Trail Project (No. C243910) In The Amount Of Four

Hundred Ninety- One Thousand Eight Hundred Thirty-One Dollars

(\$491,831.00)

SUMMARY

A resolution has been prepared authorizing the City Administrator, or her designee, to award a construction contract to McGuire & Hester for the Alameda Avenue, Oakland Waterfront Bay Trail Project (No.C243910) in the amount of \$491,831.00. McGuire & Hester is the lowest responsive and responsible bidder. Based on the use of Federal grant funds for this project, Federal Department of Transportation (DOT) guidelines are used to administer this project, and thus the City's Local Business Enterprise programs are not applicable. In addition, the project has been classified as race neutral under the DOT Implementation Agreement and therefore participation in the Federal Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) program is not required. However, McGuire & Hester is a Certified Local Business Enterprise.

The scope of the project involves the construction of new Class I bicycle/pedestrian pathways, new Class II bike lanes, and various street and landscaping improvements along the Oakland Waterfront Bay Trail on Alameda Avenue between Fruitvale Avenue and Howard Street. The design of this project was funded under the "Oakland Trust for Clean Water and Safe Parks" general obligation bond (Measure DD). Funding for the construction of this project is available through a Transportation Development Act grant, a Bay Trail grant, and a Recreational Trail Program grant.

The project is located in Council District 5.

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FISCAL IMPACT

The Alameda Avenue, Oakland Waterfront Bay Trail construction contract is funded with \$253,621.00 from a Transportation Development Act grant approved through Resolution No. 79900 C.M.S. (Project C243911, Fund 2162, Capital Management Organization 92270); \$193,000.00 from a Bay Trail grant approved through Resolution No. 79391 C.M.S. (Project C243912, Fund 2159, Capital Management Organization 92270); and \$165,000.00 from a Recreational Trail Program grant approved through Resolution No. 79487 C.M.S. (Project C243913, Fund 2134, Capital Management Organization 92270).

The Contract Compliance fee and the Public Art fee have been allocated under Project C243910. Operations and maintenance costs for this project will be included in the Public Works Agency 2007-2009 budget. Litter pick-up and graffiti abatement costs will vary based on the use of the trail and frequency of vandalism. Each individual service call to the project is estimated to be at least \$200.00.

BACKGROUND

In September 2003, the Oakland Waterfront Trail Feasibility Study was completed and provided a basis for continuity and development of the Oakland Waterfront Trail. One recommendation of the Study was to construct and connect a trail approximately 6.6 miles long, parallel to the shoreline along the Estuary from Jack London Square to 66th Avenue. Funding for portions of the trail construction and improvements was provided through the "Oakland Trust for Clean Water and Safe Parks" general obligation bond (Measure DD). The Alameda Avenue, Oakland Waterfront Bay Trail project is one of the initial trail projects to be implemented. Measure DD funding was utilized to design the project, and supplemental funding from three grant sources (Transportation Development Act, Bay Trail, and Recreational Trail Program) was secured for the project's construction contract.

On January 8, 2007, the City Clerk received five bids for the Alameda Avenue, Oakland Waterfront Bay Trail project. McGuire & Hester, Rosas Brothers Construction, Granite Rock Company, Bay Construction, and Ray's Electric submitted bids of \$491,831.00, \$494,910.00, \$496,949.00,539,660.00 and \$587,630.00, respectively. The proposal of \$491,831.00 submitted by McGuire & Hester is the lowest responsive and responsible bid. Please Refer to Attachment A for a summary of bids. The engineer's estimate of the construction cost is \$522,197.00.

KEY ISSUES AND IMPACTS

Construction of the Alameda Avenue, Oakland Waterfront Bay Trail project will enhance the access and appearance of the shoreline trail on Alameda Avenue south of Fruitvale Avenue. The implementation of this project will bring the City closer to its goal of creating a continuous shoreline trail along the Oakland Estuary.

Item: _____ Public Works Committee March 27, 2007 Based on the use of Federal grant funds for this project, Federal Department of Transportation (DOT) guidelines are used to administer this project, and thus the City's Local Business Enterprise programs are not applicable. In addition, the project has been classified as race neutral under the DOT Implementation Agreement and therefore participation in the Federal Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) program is not required. The Contract Compliance & Employment Services Division of the City Administrator's Office has analyzed the contractor bid data and the information is provided in *Attachment B*. Additionally, McGuire & Hester is a certified local business and is compliant with the Equal Benefits Ordinance (EBO).

Upon approval of the resolution, a contract will be awarded and construction can begin as soon as May 2007. The project duration is 60 working days from the date of the Notice to Proceed and completion is anticipated by August 2007. The construction contract specifies \$1,000.00 in liquidated damages per calendar day if the contract completion time of 60 working days is exceeded. The project schedule is shown on *Attachment A*.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The scope of the project involves the construction of new Class I bicycle/pedestrian pathways, new Class II bike lanes, and various street and landscaping improvements along the Oakland Waterfront Bay Trail on Alameda Avenue between Fruitvale Avenue and Howard Street.

SUSTAINABLE OPPORTUNITIES

<u>Economic</u>: The project will generate jobs for Oakland residents, and business tax, sales tax and other revenues for the City by those who work on the project.

<u>Environmental:</u> The contractor will be required to use recyclable construction materials to the extent feasible and is required to recycle construction debris.

<u>Social Equity:</u> The project will enhance access to the waterfront shoreline and will provide a recreational trail for use.

DISABILITY AND SENIOR CITIZEN ACCESS

All new physical improvements will comply with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA). The project will improve accessibility for persons with disabilities and for senior citizens to the waterfront shoreline.

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RECOMMENDATION AND RATIONALE

It is recommended that the City Administrator, or her designee, be authorized to award a construction contract to McGuire & Hester for the Alameda Avenue, Oakland Waterfront Bay Trail project (C243910) in the amount of four hundred ninety- one thousand eight hundred thirty-one dollars (\$491,831.00). Sufficient funds are available to construct this project.

ACTION REQUESTED OF THE CITY COUNCIL

Staff recommends that the City Council approve the resolution.

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR, OR HER DESIGNEE, TO AWARD A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT TO MCGUIRE & HESTER FOR THE ALAMEDA AVENUE, OAKLAND WATERFRONT BAY TRAIL PROJECT (C243910) IN THE AMOUNT OF FOUR HUNDRED NINETY ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED THIRTY-ONE DOLLARS (\$491,831.00)

WHEREAS, on January 8, 2007, five bids were received by the Office of the City Clerk for the Alameda Avenue, Oakland Waterfront bay Trail Project; and

WHEREAS, McGuire & Hester (Oakland) is the lowest responsive and responsible bidder; and

WHEREAS, due to the use of Federal grant funds, Department of Transportation (DOT) guidelines are used to administer this project and the City's Local Business Enterprise programs are not applicable; and

WHEREAS, the project has been classified as race neutral under the DOT Implementation Agreement and participation in the Federal Disadvantaged Business Enterprise program is not required; and

WHEREAS, sufficient funding is available for the construction contract from a Transportation Development Act grant (\$253,621.00 in Project C243911, Fund 2162, Capital Management Organization 92270); a Bay Trail grant (\$193,000 in Project C243912, Fund 2159, Capital Management Organization 92270); and a Recreational Trail Program grant (\$165,000 in Project C243913, Fund 2134, Capital Management Organization 92270); and

WHEREAS, the City lacks the equipment and qualified personnel to perform the necessary work; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds and determines that the performance of this contract is in the public interest because of economy; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that services under this contract will be temporary; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds and determines that the performance of this contract shall not result in the loss of employment or salary by any person having permanent status in the competitive service; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED: That the City Administrator, or her designee, is hereby authorized to award a construction contract on behalf of the City of Oakland for the Alameda Avenue, Oakland Waterfront Bay Trail project to McGuire & Hester in the amount of four hundred ninety one thousand eight hundred thirty-one dollars (\$491,831.00) and to execute any amendments or modifications of said contract within the limitations of the project specifications; and be it
