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A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH THE EAST BAY A SIAN LOCAL DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$50,000 FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE EASTLAKE MAIN STREET PROGRAM IN THE SAN ANTONIO DISTRICT

WHEREAS, the Community and Economic Development Agency's Neighborhood Commercial Revitalization Unit has allocated \$50,000 from Community Development Block Grant funds for commercial revitalization in the EastLake community; and

WHEREAS, the Community and Economic Development Agency's Neighborhood Commercial Revitalization Unit is the sponsoring agency and has been working in partnership with the East Bay Asian Local Development Corporation and the Unity Council to develop and implement the Main Street approach in the EastLake commercial corridor; and

WHEREAS, funds have been allocated by the Local Initiative Support Corporation Foundation for the Neighborhood Main Street Initiative Program; and

WHEREAS, City staff has recommended a funding allocation in an amount not to exceed \$50,000 with the East Bay Asian Local Development Corporation to implement the EastLake Main Street Program in the San Antonio District; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED: That the City Manager or his or her designee is authorized to negotiate and enter into a contract to provide funding in an amount not to exceed \$50,000 to the East Bay Asian Local Development Corporation to implement the EastLake Main Street Program in the San Antonio District, and be it further

RESOLVED: That funds for said contracts shall come from Community Development Block Grant funds allocated for commercial revitalization services in the EastLake commercial corridor; and be it further

RESOLVED: That City funding under each of said contracts shall be conditioned on the commitment at least \$100,000 in matching funds from other sources; and be it further

RESOLVED: That the City Council hereby authorizes the City Manager or his designee as agent of the City of Oakland to conduct negotiations, execute documents, and take any other actions with respect to the funding and the contracts consistent with this Resolution and its basic purpose.
