Iris Winograd has dedicated much of her free time during the last five years to volunteer work in Oakland. Her activities include a board position with the League of Women Voters, Oakland which just concluded. Currently, she is on the board of Parental Stress Services, and The League of Women Voters, Bay Area. To that point, she has completed the course offered by the City of Oakland Citizen's Academy in 2002 to prepare for an Oakland volunteer position.

With a B.S. degree in Political Science from Northwestern University in Evanston, IL and a Masters Degree in Social Welfare from University of Wisconsin-Milwaukee, Ms. Winograd has always had a strong interest in civic participation. She taught university courses on social policy for 10 years before resigning for graduate studies in Developmental Psychology at the University of Wisconsin-Madison. Upon receiving her Ph.D. (1979) she took a faculty post at the Medical College of Wisconsin where she taught Community Medicine in the Department of Preventive Medicine, among other courses, and conducted research for eight years. Her final years of employment in Wisconsin were devoted to clinical and consulting psychology.

Ms. Winograd's other volunteer activities include working with the Prescott Neighborhood Crime Prevention Council initiative on truancy intervention at the Cole Elementary School and Lowell Elementary School. She also co-chairs the Alameda County Leagues of Women Voters juvenile justice committee which is participating in the County study of the juvenile justice system.
