INTRODUCED BY COUNCILMEMBER.

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE CONTRACTS BETWEEN THE CITY AND NINE OAKLAND NONPROFIT AGENCIES (ADULT DAY SERVICES NETWORK OF ALAMEDA COUNTY, ALAMEDA COUNTY COMMUNITY FOOD BANK, BAY AREA COMMUNITY SERVICES, FAMILY BRIDGES, LAVENDER SENIORS, LAO FAMILY COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT, LIFELONG MEDICAL CARE, MERCY RETIREMENT AND CARE CENTER, AND ST. MARY'S CENTER) TO PROVIDE SERVICES TO SENIOR CITIZENS UNDER THE SENIOR SERVICES "SET-ASIDE" FUNDING WHICH RESULTED FROM THE \$2 PARKING TICKET INCREASE FOR FISCAL YEAR 2003-04 IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$348,870.

WHEREAS, the City of Oakland has established a fund to support unmet senior service needs for Oakland citizens by increasing various parking citations by two dollars per ticket as per the requirements of Ordinance #11985; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has committed to maintain a set aside to fund unmet senior needs; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has appropriated \$295,139 and carried forward \$53,731 to provide \$348,870 in parking ticket revenues for FY 2003-2004 to be awarded on a competitive basis to Oakland nonprofit organizations that can meet critical senior needs; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that the performance of these services are in the public interest because of economy; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that these contracts will not result in the loss of employment or salary by any person having permanent status in the civil service; and

WHEREAS, the City wishes to enter into contracts with nine highest ranked applicant nonprofits in an amount not to exceed the amounts specified below for each agency for the period of July 1, 2003 to June 30, 2004:

RESOLVED: That said agreement(s) shall be approved as to form and legality by the Office of the City Attorney and placed on file in the Office of the City Clerk.
