RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO APPROPRIATE \$50,000 IN REVENUE AND EXPENDITURE TO THE COMMUNITY AND ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT AGENCY BUILDING DMSION

**WHEREAS,** City staff has identified approximately twenty-five (25) vehicular food vendors operating illegally in the City of Oakland; and

**WHEREAS**, the vehicular food vendors provide a service to the Oakland community with convenient hours of operation; and,

**WHEREAS,** City staff has received complaints about nuisances related to the vehicular food vending use; and

**WHEREAS**, implementation of the Vehicular Food Vending Pilot Program would result in increased costs to the City for administration, enforcement and monitoring of the program, estimated at a cost of \$2,000 per vendor; and

WHEREAS, it is anticipated that twenty-five (25) vehicular food vendors would apply for permits under the Vehicular Food Vending Pilot Program; and

WHEREAS, fees would generate approximately \$50,000 in revenues; and

**WHEREAS,** the City Council finds and determines that the public safety, health, convenience, comfort, property, and general welfare will be furthered by enforcement of the Vehicular Food Vending Pilot Program; now therefore,

**RESOLVED:** That the City Manager is hereby authorized to appropriate \$50,000 in revenue and expenditure to the Community and Economic Development Agency Building Services Division
