RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO APPROPRIATE \$50,000 IN REVENUE AND EXPENDITURE TO THE COMMUNITY AND ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT AGENCY BUILDING DIVISION

WHEREAS, City staff has identified approximately twenty-five (25) vehicular food vendors operating illegally in the City of Oakland; and

WHEREAS, the vehicular food vendors provide a service to the Oakland community with convenient hours of operation; and,

WHEREAS, City staff has received complaints about nuisances related to the vehicular food vending use; and

WHEREAS, implementation of the Vehicular Food Vending Pilot Program would result in increased costs to the City for administration, enforcement and monitoring of the program, estimated at a cost of \$2,000 per vendor; and

WHEREAS, it is anticipated that twenty-five (25) vehicular food vendors would apply for permits under the Vehicular Food Vending Pilot Program; and

WHEREAS, fees would generate approximately \$50,000 in revenues; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds and determines that the public safety, health, convenience, comfort, property, and general welfare will be furthered by enforcement of the Vehicular Food Vending Pilot Program; now therefore,

RESOLVED: That the City Manager is hereby authorized to appropriate \$50,000 in revenue and expenditure to the Community and Economic Development Agency Building Services Division
