INTRODUCED BY MAYOR BARBARA LEE

A RESOLUTION CONFIRMING THE MAYOR'S APPOINTMENT OF FELECIAI FAVROTH TO THE LANDMARKS PRESERVATION ADVISORY BOARD

WHEREAS, Section 601 of the City Charter provides that members of City boards and commissions shall be appointed by the Mayor subject to confirmation by the affirmative vote of five members of the City Council; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 192 C.M.S. creates the Landmarks Preservation Advisory Board, whose members are nominated by the Mayor and confirmed by the City Council; and

WHEREAS, the Landmarks Preservation Advisory Board consists of seven members including but not limited to Landscape Architect or City Planner, Oakland Historian or Architectural Historian, Real Estate Broker, and Architect, whose members of the Landmarks Preservation Advisory Board are to serve three year terms, which are to be staggered so that some appointments will expire every year, and appointments to fill a term of office are only to be for the remainder of that term; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable Mayor Barbara Lee, appoints Feleciai Favroth to the Landmarks Preservation Advisory Board for the terms stated below; now, therefore, be it

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RESOLVED: That pursuant to City Charter section 601, the City Council hereby confirms the Mayor's appointments to the Landmarks Preservation Advisory Board as follows:

Feleciai Favroth, as a Real Estate Broker member to serve a three-year term beginning on February 22, 2026 and ending February 21, 2029.

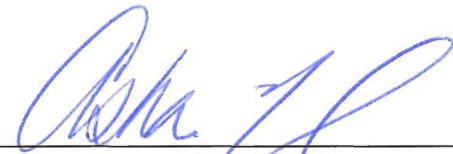
