RESOLUTION CONFIRMING THE MAYOR'S APPOINTMENT OF BENJAMIN SCOTT AS A MEMBER OF THE HOUSING, RESIDENTIAL RENT AND RELOCATION BOARD

WHEREAS, Section 601 of the City Charter provides that members of City boards and commissions shall be appointed by the Mayor subject to confirmation by the affirmative vote of five members of the City Council; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 8.22 of the Oakland Municipal Code creates the Housing, Residential Rent and Relocation Board to encourage investment in residential housing while also protecting the welfare of residential tenants; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 8.22 of the Oakland Municipal Code specifies that members of the Housing Residential Rent and Relocation Board are to serve three year terms, which are to be staggered so that one-third of the appointments will expire every year, and appointments to fill a term of office are only to be for the remainder of that term; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable Mayor Ronald V. Dellums has appointed Benjamin Scott to serve a three-year term on the Housing, Residential Rent and Relocation Board beginning February 12, 2009 and ending February 11, 2012 filling the landlord seat previously held by Ricardo Hunter, subject to confirmation by the City Council; now therefore be it

RESOLVED, that pursuant to City Charter section 601, the City Council hereby confirms the Mayor's appointment of **Benjamin Scott** to the Housing, Residential Rent and Relocation Board in the seat designated for a landlord, for the three-year term beginning February 12, 2009 and ending February 11, 2012 filling the landlord seat previously held by Ricardo Hunter.
