

Resolution Appointing Donald Johnson As A Member Of The Wildfire Prevention Assessment District Advisory Board

Whereas, Ordinance No. 12556 creates the Wildfire Prevention Assessment District Advisory Board, which will provide oversight and program recommendations for the Assessment District, and will play a key role in the continued implementation of vegetation management programs and the development of fuel management strategies; and

Whereas, Ordinance No. 12556 specifies that the Mayor shall appoint two (2) constituents who live in the Assessment District, one of whom shall be a firefighter by profession, to serve as follows: Initially, one appointee shall serve for a term of two years (through June 30, 2006); the second appointee shall serve for a term or three years (through June 30, 2007). Thereafter, each subsequent appointment shall be for a term of two years; and

Whereas, Ordinance No. 12556 specifies that the At-Large Councilmember shall appoint one (1) constituent who lives in the Assessment District, and who shall serve for a term of two years (through June 30, 2006). Thereafter, each subsequent appointment shall be for a term of two years; and

Whereas, Ordinance No. 12556 specifies that each of the four (4) Wildfire Prevention Assessment District Councilmembers shall appoint two (2) constituents each, who live in the Assessment District to serve as follows: Initially, one appointee shall serve for a term of two years (through June 30, 2006); the second appointee shall serve for a term or three years (through June 30, 2007). Thereafter, each subsequent appointment shall be for a term of two years; and therefore be it

Resolved: that by appointment of the Mayor the following individual is hereby reappointed as set forth below:

DONALD JOHNSON, Mayoral appointment, recommended by Councilmember Larry Reid (District 7), to serve the term beginning July 1, 2008 and ending June 30, 2010, filling the seat previously held by Allene Warren.
