RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY ATTORNEY TO COMPROMISE AND SETTLE THE CLAIM OF GREATER MIRACLE TEMPLE, CITY ATTORNEY FILE NO. C35492, IN THE AMOUNT OF ONE HUNDRED AND TWO THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED EIGHTY DOLLARS AND SEVEN CENTS (\$102,980.07) (DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS – FAILED SEWER MAIN)

WHEREAS, Greater Miracle Temple (“Claimant”) alleges that on March 11, 2022, a blockage in the City’s sewer main caused damage to Claimant’s property; and

WHEREAS, Claimant submitted the above-entitled claim seeking compensation for said damages; and

WHEREAS, the City of Oakland has determined that settlement in the amount of One Hundred Two Thousand Nine Hundred Eighty Dollars and Seven Cents (\$102,980.07), without an admission of liability, is in the best interest of the City; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED: That the City Attorney is authorized and directed to compromise and settle the claim of Greater Miracle Temple, City Attorney’s File No. C35492, for the sum of One Hundred Two Thousand Nine Hundred Eighty Dollars and Seven Cents (\$102,980.07); and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Attorney is further authorized and directed to take whatever steps may be necessary to effect said settlement.
