

**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR OR
DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE A GRANT AGREEMENT WITH THE
OAKLAND CHINATOWN CHAMBER OF COMMERCE (OCCC) IN THE
AMOUNT OF \$75,000 FOR SECURITY CAMERAS AND LIGHTING.**

WHEREAS, The Chinatown Chamber has taken the lead and worked with the Oakland Police Department (OPD) on a proposal to install security cameras on private property at key locations in Chinatown to deter crime and aid in criminal investigations; and

WHEREAS, in 2012, OPD and the Chamber jointly identified sixteen (16) Security Camera locations on private owned buildings as being of strategic importance; and

WHEREAS, the Chamber received Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funding to execute the (16) camera project, and these cameras are still being used as a key resource in the Oakland Chinatown District when OPD needs to check on video surveillance for reported crimes; and

WHEREAS, an additional twenty (20) key locations were identified and approved for grant funding by the City Council in the 2018 Mid Cycle Budget Adjustment process; and

WHEREAS, funds in the amount of \$75,000 were allocated by the City Council in the 2018-19 Mid Cycle Budget and are available; and

WHEREAS, in order for the Chamber to implement the installation of the next 20 camera and lighting locations, a grant agreement between the Chamber and the City needs to be executed; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED: That the City Council hereby authorizes the City Administrator or designees the Director of Transportation or Assistant Director of Transportation to execute a grant agreement with the Oakland Chinatown Chamber of Commerce, for the procurement and installation of security cameras and lighting.
