RESOLUTION WAIVING FURTHER COMPETITIVE REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL (RFP) REQUIREMENTS AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO AMEND THE PROFESSIONAL SERVICES CONTRACT WITH BIGGS CARDOSA ASSOCIATES, INC. (BCA) FOR THE LEIMERT BRIDGE SEISMIC RETROFIT PROJECT (PROJECT NO. 1000820) BY INCREASING THE CONTRACT AMOUNT BY ONE HUNDRED FIFTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$150,000.00) FOR A TOTAL CONTRACT AMOUNT NOT-TO-EXCEED ONE MILLION EIGHT HUNDRED FORTY THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED SEVENTY-NINE DOLLARS AND TWENTY CENTS (\$1,840,279.20)

WHEREAS, the Leimert Bridge over Sausal Creek was identified by the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) for need of seismic retrofit; and

WHEREAS, Caltrans provided funding to the City for obtaining environmental approvals, securing permits, and finalizing the construction documents; and

WHEREAS, BCA was selected through a competitive request for proposals (RFP) process by the City of Oakland to prepare the design for Leimert Boulevard Bridge Seismic Retrofit; and

WHEREAS, the City completed the construction documents for the Leimert Boulevard Bridge Seismic Retrofit Project (Project No. 1000820) and requested authorization to proceed with construction from the Caltrans; and

WHEREAS, on June 28, 2022, Caltrans approved the construction phase of the project and obligated a grant of federal and state funds in the amount of \$4,184,715.00; and

WHEREAS, on June 6, 2023, the City awarded a construction contract to Disney Construction, Inc. for the Leimert Bridge Seismic Retrofit; and

WHEREAS, due to unforeseen and changed field conditions, additional BCA design services assistance were needed to successfully complete the project; and

WHEREAS, the increase in the contract amount will pay for BCA design support until the end of construction; and

WHEREAS, the increase in the contract amount will be reimbursed by the project grant of federal and state funding and other local matching funding; and

WHEREAS, staff is requesting additional grant funds from Caltrans to cover the cost; and

WHEREAS, grant funding for the increase of the contract of up to \$1,840,279.20 is available in the following accounts: Project 1000820, Funds 2218 and 5337

WHEREAS, the City lacks the equipment and qualified personnel to perform the necessary work, and the City Council finds and determines that the performance of this contract is in the public interest because of economy and the reasons cited in the agenda report; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that this contract is of a professional, scientific, or technical and temporary in nature and shall not result in the loss of employment or salary by any person having permanent status in the competitive service; now, therefore, be it

WHEREAS, Section 2.04.051(B) of the Oakland Municipal Code (the "OMC") authorizes the City Council to waive the advertising and competitive bidding requirements of Section 2.04.051(A) upon a finding and determination that it is in the best interests of the City to do so; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED: That the City Administrator is authorized to execute an amendment to the contract with BCA extending the contract and increasing the scope of services and contract by an amount not-to-exceed One Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$150,000.00) for a total contract amount not-to-exceed One Million Eight Hundred Forty Thousand Two Hundred Seventy-Nine Dollars and Twenty Cents (\$1,840,279.20) contingent upon the availability of funding; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Council finds it is in the best interest of the City to waive the competitive RFP process in OMC 2.04.051(A) given the nature and scope of this technical work; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Administrator is authorized to approve any subsequent amendments to or extensions of said agreement, provided that such amendments or extensions shall be filed with the City Clerk's Office; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the contract shall be reviewed and approved by the City Attorney for form and legality and placed on file in the Office of the City Clerk.
