## RESOLUTION APPROVING THE CONVERSION OF E.16 $^{\rm TH}$ AND E.17 $^{\rm TH}$ STREETS FROM 62 $^{\rm ND}$ TO 64 $^{\rm TH}$ AVENUES TO ONE-WAY STREETS

WHEREAS, at three community meetings sponsored by Oakland Community Organizations with Saint Bernard Church and School, Whittier School, local residents, and City officials and staff, community representatives showed preponderant support in favor of the one-way conversion; therefore, be it

RESOLVED: That the conversion of East 16<sup>th</sup> and East 17<sup>th</sup> streets between 62<sup>nd</sup> and 64" avenues from two-way to one-way operation is hereby approved.
