**RESOLUTION RECOMMENDING TO THE CIVIL SERVICE BOARD
THAT THE CLASSIFICATION OF CHIEF CONSERVATOR BE
EXCEPTED FROM CIVIL SERVICE**

WHEREAS, Oakland City Charter Section 902(f) authorizes the City Council to recommend for Civil Service Board approval the exception of positions from the requirements of Civil Service; and

WHEREAS, the classification of Chief Conservator is a management level position with responsibility for overall administration of the Conservation Program at the Oakland Museum and for the conservation of Museum Collections; and

WHEREAS, the nature and scope of this position poses substantial confidentiality and liability risks to the City and the City must be able to take immediate action to protect its interests when necessary; and

WHEREAS, the City Administrator has determined that it is necessary to except the classification of Chief Conservator from the requirements and tenure of civil service because the nature of the work performed does not lend itself to the selection and retention processes for employment established by the City's civil service system; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: the City Council hereby recommends to the Civil Service Board that the classification of Chief Conservator be excepted from Civil Service.


