2006 JUNA 5RESOL OFION AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO ENTER INTO A CULTURAL SERVICES CONTRACT WITH OAKLAND LEAF, AN OAKLAND-BASED NONPROFIT ORGANIZATION, PROVIDING ARTS AND CULTURAL SERVICES IN OAKLAND DURING FISCAL YEAR 2006-2007 IN A TOTAL AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$32,000.00

WHEREAS, in 1985 the first arts funding policies and procedures were adopted by the City Council, which established a panel system of evaluating funding proposals and distributing City funds to the arts; and

WHEREAS, the Cultural Funding Program is the City's funding mechanism to support Oaklandbased nonprofit organizations and artists providing arts and cultural activities to the public; and

WHEREAS, the mission of the Cultural Funding Program is to fund Oakland-based art and cultural activities that reflect the diversity of the city for the citizens of and visitors to Oakland, focusing on three key areas: 1) General Support, 2) Neighborhood Arts and 3) Arts Education; and

WHEREAS, during March 2006, four funding review panels convened and forwarded recommendations to fund seventy-three (73) organizations and individual artists proposing to provide arts and/or cultural programming in the city of Oakland, of which Oakland Leaf is one such organization; and

WHEREAS, funding is budgeted for cultural services contracts in FY 2006-07 and is available within the General Purpose Fund (1010); CCAD Cultural Programs Organization (90523) totaling \$1,048,360, and Cultural Funding Organization (62512) totaling \$131,901.96; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that this contract is for services of a professional nature; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that services under this contract will be temporary in nature; therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the Oakland City Council hereby approves and authorizes a contract with Oakland Leaf in the amount detailed; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That in the event any of the above awards are not encumbered, that those funds shall revert to the Cultural Funding Program for use in other categories of support; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Council hereby appoints the City Administrator or her designated representative as agent of the City to conduct all negotiations, execute and submit all documents, including but not limited to agreements, amendments, modifications, payment requests, and related actions which may be necessary for the completion of the aforementioned contract in accordance with their basic purpose; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the Office of the City Attorney will approve the contract for form and legality and a copy will be on file in the Office of the City Clerk.
