NOTICE AND DIGEST

AN ORDINANCE ADDING CHAPTER 9.08.270 TO CHAPTER 9 OF THE OAKLAND MUNICIPAL CODE ESTABLISHING THE RIGHT TO PHOTOGRAPH, VIDEO AND/OR AUDIO RECORD POLICE AND/OR PEACE OFFICER(S)

This ordinance adds Chapter 9.08.270 to the Oakland Municipal Code, which provides:

A. The fact that a person takes a photograph or makes an audio or video recording of a police officer or peace officer, while the officer is in a public place or the person taking the photograph or making the recording is in a place he or she has the right to be, does not constitute, in and of itself, a violation.

B. Further, the fact that a person takes a photograph or makes an audio or video recording of a police officer or peace officer, while the officer is in a public place or the person taking the photograph or making the recording is in a place he or she has the right to be, does not constitute, in and of itself, reasonable suspicion to detain the person or probable cause to arrest the person.

C. This Chapter 9.08.270 shall not be subject to the General Penalties proscribed in Oakland Municipal Code Chapter 1.28 nor any other penalty provision of the Oakland Municipal Code.
