

Public Hearing on Assessment of Liens for Delinquent Transient Occupancy

Taxes

#### **SUMMARY**

On March 19, 2004, staff held an administrative hearing for delinquent Transient Occupancy Taxes and attempted to resolve any inconsistencies or inequities prior to the public hearing before the City Council. The administrative and public hearings are held only after all other procedural means to resolve an unpaid Transient Occupancy Tax have been exhausted.

#### FISCAL IMPACT

The liens will be recorded against five (5) parcels owned by five (5) property owners. The parcels' delinquencies represent \$167,375 in past due Transient Occupancy Taxes. The amount of taxes to be recovered through the lien process has been included in the current revenue baseline. There is no impact on the General Fund.

#### **BACKGROUND**

Six (6) property owners were originally notified of the City's intent to record a lien against their property for delinquent Transient Occupancy Taxes. One (1) account was resolved because the hotel owner paid his delinquency in full.

#### KEY ISSUES AND IMPACTS

There are no key issues or impacts.

#### POLICY DESCRIPTION

Chapter 4, Article 24 of the Oakland Municipal Code enables staff to submit recommendations to Council for the recordation of a lien for delinquent Transient Occupancy Taxes.

#### SUSTAINABLE OPPORTUNITIES

There are no sustainable opportunities that are being addressed under this report.

#### DISABILITY AND SENIOR CITIZEN ACCESS

#### RECOMMENDATION AND RATIONALE

Staff recommends approval of a resolution accepting and confirming the report from the City Manager on delinquent Transient Occupancy Taxes and confirming the recordation of liens, administrative charges, and assessment charges with the County Recorder's Office.

#### ALTERNATIVE RECOMMENDATIONS

There are no alternative recommendations.

#### **ACTION REQUESTED OF THE CITY COUNCIL**

The City Council is requested to approve the placement of liens for the five (5) parcels/properties and to authorize the subsequent assessment for all taxes and charges should they remain unpaid at the time required for submission to the County Assessor. The owners of the five (5) parcels/properties failed to resolve the delinquencies during the administrative hearing.

Resolutions confirming the staff recommendations have been prepared for City Council consideration.
