RESOLUTION NO. 9076 2 C.M.S.

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO ACCEPT AND APPROPRIATE THE SUSTAINABLE TRANSPORTATION PLANNING GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF TWO HUNDRED AND SIXTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$260,000) TO FUND CITY ANALYSIS AND ENGAGEMENT OF PORT-LED SEA LEVEL RISE AND GROUND WATER INTRUSION MODELING.

WHEREAS, The Port of Oakland and adjacent communities are especially vulnerable to sea-level rise, future extreme weather events, and ground water intrusion;

WHEREAS, on August 16, 2024, the Port of Oakland received a Sustainable Transportation Planning Grant from the California Department of Transportation ("CalTrans") for \$3,000,000 to fulfill the project described in the proposed Rising Seas and Oakland's Infrastructure and Frontline Communities: Climate Adaptation Planning, to deliver cumulative sea level rise and ground water intrusion modeling and vulnerability assessments; and

WHEREAS, on September 26, 2024, the Board of Port Commissioners adopted Port Resolution 24-75 approving and authorizing execution of the Grant agreement with CalTrans and any ancillary agreements, such as individual subgrant agreements with project partners; and

WHEREAS, the City has been identified as a project partner; and

WHEREAS, the project is aligned with numerous local, regional, and State climate adaptation planning efforts, including the Oakland Equitable Climate Action Plan; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED: That the City Council authorizes the City Administrator to accept and appropriate the Sustainable Transportation Planning Grant allocation in the amount of two hundred and sixty thousand dollars (\$260,000); and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That appropriations will be allocated into Fund 2999 – Miscellaneous Grant, with the organization, account, and project to be determined (TBD); and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Administrator is authorized to take all steps necessary to finalize the appropriate fund, organization, account, and project codes once the specific use and departmental allocations are confirmed; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Administrator is hereby authorized to complete all required negotiations, certifications, assurances, and documentation required to accept, modify, extend, and/or amend the agreement.


