AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OAKLAND AUTHORIZING AN AMENDMENT TO THE CONTRACT BETWEEN THE CITY OF OAKLAND AND THE BOARD OF ADMINISTRATION OF THE CALIFORNIA EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT SYSTEM (CaIPERS) THAT AUTHORIZES CONVERSION OF UP TO SEVENTY-FIVE PERCENT (75%) OF UNUSED ACCUMULATED SICK LEAVE TO ADDITIONAL SERVICE CREDIT FOR MEMBERS OF THE INTERNATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF FIREFIGHTERS, LOCAL 55

WHEREAS, on June 26, 2001, the City Council approved a Memorandum of Understanding between the City of Oakland and the International Association of Firefighters, Local 55 pursuant to Resolution No. 76546 C.M.S; and

WHEREAS, Article 6, Section 6.1.4 of said Memorandum of Understanding provides that pursuant to California Government Code section 20965, effective July 1, 2005, a bargaining unit member who retires on a regular, non-disability retirement may elect to convert up to seventy-five percent (75%) of the unit member's unused accumulated sick leave to additional service credit at the rate of 0.004 years of service credit for each day of unused sick leave; and

WHEREAS, implementation of Article 6, Section 6.1.4 requires an amendment to the contract between the City of Oakland and the Board of Administration of the California Public Employees' Retirement System; now, therefore

### THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OAKLAND DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That an amendment to the contract between the City of Oakland and the Board of Administration of the California Public Employees' Retirement System is hereby authorized, a copy of said amendment being attached hereto as Exhibit 1, and by such reference made part hereof as though herein set out in full.

<u>Section 2</u>. The President of the Council is hereby authorized, empowered and directed to execute said amendment for and on behalf of the City of Oakland.

Section 3. The effective date of this Ordinance shall be immediate if at least six Council Members vote in favor of the Ordinance, otherwise, it will take effect on the seventh day after final adoption.
