## LGBTQ Youth Services – Total Program Grants for

**FY2014-2016**

In April 2014, the POC approved *renewal of grants supporting:*

- **AIDS Project of the East Bay – Save Our LGBTQI Youth Program with SMAAC Youth Center (\$150,000)**
- **Youth UpRising’s Queer & Allies Initiative (\$146,500)**

If approved, OFCY will provide funding support for five grants totaling **\$533,875** in FY2014-2015.

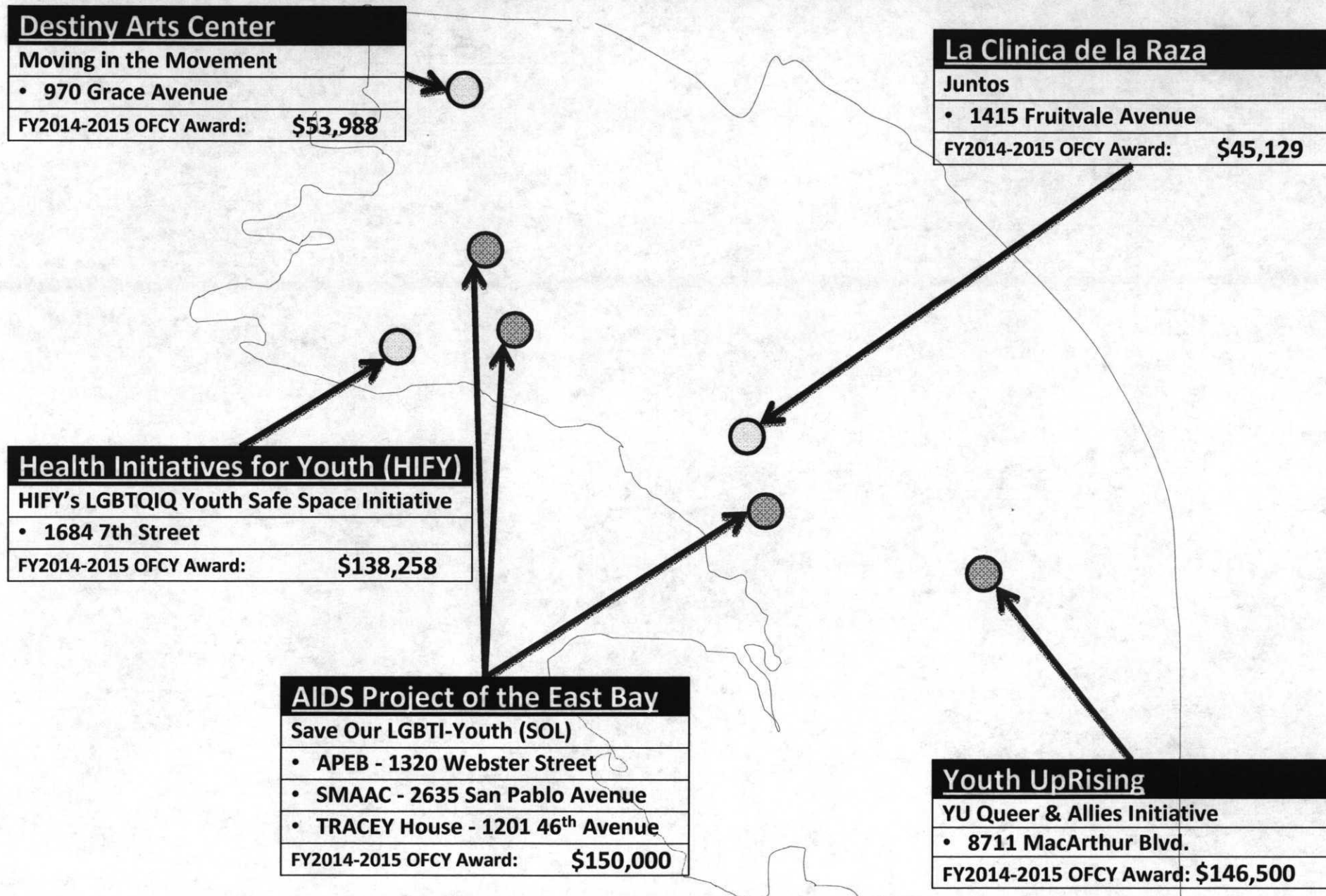

## OFCY - LGBTQ Youth Services

OFCY's **Safe Community Spaces for LGBTQ Youth** funding strategy was developed by the POC and approved by City Council in February 2014.

- Safe, Transit-Accessible Community Spaces
- Positive Youth Development Activities
- Qualified and Culturally Competent Staff
- Access to a Network of Services, Support and Referrals for LGBTQ Youth and their Families.
- Building Strong and Secure Peer Relations.

OFCY released an RFP for **LGBTQ Youth Services** in February 2014 to implement the strategy.

Average scores of reviewers form the preliminary ranking of applicants.</p>	<p>The POC formed an Ad-Hoc Review Interview Subcommittee to receive the external readers' scores and ranking, interview applicants, and form preliminary ranking.</p>	<p>The POC receives the preliminary funding recommendations from the Interview Subcommittee and makes final recommendations of providers and grant awards. The funding recommendation is forwarded to Oakland City Council for approval.</p>
