WHEREAS, the duration of the Head Start Advisory Board was extended in April 2004 through December 31, 2010 and shall dissolve on December 31, 2010, unless reauthorized by the City Council; and

WHEREAS, the Head Start Advisory Board members serve on a voluntary basis; and

WHEREAS, funding to cover the cost of staff time to support the Head Start Advisory Board is budgeted under the Department of Health and Human Services Head Start Program Fund (2128), Head Start Unit Organization (78231), HS PY40 Operations FY10-11 Project (G358310), and Strengthening Children, Youth and Families Program (YS13); and

WHEREAS, to ensure the efficient and continued operation of the Oakland Head Start program; now, therefore bit it,

RESOLVED, That the City Administrator is hereby authorized and directed to extend the duration of the Head Start Advisory Board through December 2016.
