RESOLUTION AWARDING GRANTS TO FIFTEEN (15) OAKLAND-BASED NONPROFIT ORGANIZATIONS PROVIDING ARTS INSTRUCTION FOR OAKLAND YOUTH THROUGH JUNE 30, 2025, IN A TOTAL AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED ONE HUNDRED FIFTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$150,000)

**WHEREAS,** in 1985, the City Council adopted the first arts funding policies and procedures for the City of Oakland (City), establishing the Cultural Funding Program, which includes a panel system of evaluating funding proposals and distributing City funds to the arts; and

**WHEREAS,** the Cultural Funding Program, housed in the Economic and Workforce Development Department, is the City's funding mechanism to support Oakland-based nonprofit organizations and artists providing arts and cultural activities to the public; and

**WHEREAS,** the mission of the Cultural Funding Program is to fund Oakland-based art and cultural activities that reflect the diversity of the City for citizens of and visitors to Oakland, focusing on the key areas of General Support, Neighborhood Arts, Festivals, and Arts Education; and

**WHEREAS,** in March 2024, the Cultural Funding Program convened community review panels to evaluate submitted applications for Networks of Care: Teaching Artist Support grants program. The highest scoring applications were reviewed by staff who have recommended to City Council that these grants using Cultural Funding be awarded in the amounts listed in the below table; and

**WHEREAS,** Fiscal Year 2023-24 funds for the Cultural Funding Program are available as follows: \$150,000 from the Transient Occupancy Tax surcharge, which will be reserved for arts grants in the Measure C: Transient Occupancy Tax (TOT) Surcharge Fund (2419), Cultural Arts & Marketing Org (85511), TOT Surcharge: Cultural Grants Project (1000458); and

**WHEREAS,** staff recommends that the City Council award grants to specific nonprofit organizations, as set forth in the below table:
