## OAKLAND CITY COUNCIL RESOLUTION NO. 89353 C.M.S.

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND **DIRECTING** THE CITY ATTORNEY TO COMPROMISE AND SETTLE THE CLAIMS OF PLAINTIFF WILSON RILES, JR. IN THE CASE OF WILSON RILES, JR. V. CITY OF OAKLAND, OFFICER JORGE YAUGER, OFFICER BRYANT OCAMPO, MICHAEL [SIC] LEGAULT, RICHARD FIELDING, TRACI CAMPBELL BLOCK, **CECILIA** SEVILLA, **OFFICER** JONATHAN LOW, OFFICER ALEXANDRA LOWE, AND DOES 5 THROUGH 10, UNITED STATES DISTRICT COURT, NORTHERN DISTRICT OF CALIFORNIA, CASE NO. 3:20-CV-06869-JCS, CITY ATTORNEY'S FILE NO. 33973, IN THE AMOUNT OF THREE HUNDRED SIXTY THOUSAND DOLLARS AND ZERO CENTS (\$360,000.00) (OAKLAND POLICE DEPARTMENT AND PLANNING AND BUILDING DEPARTMENT – CIVIL RIGHTS)

WHEREAS, Plaintiff Wilson Riles, Jr. went to the offices of the City of Oakland's Planning and Building Department ("PBD") on October 17, 2019 to dispute issues relating to a property inspection, refused to leave a restricted employees-only area, and was subsequently arrested by officers of the Oakland Police Department ("OPD");

WHEREAS, Plaintiff Riles, who identifies as a Black man, filed a lawsuit that is pending in the United States District Court, Northern District of California, Case No. 3:20-cv-06869-JCS, against the City of Oakland, former OPD officer Jorge Yauger, OPD officers Bryant Ocampo, Jonathan Lowe, and Alexandra Lowe, PBD employee Traci Campbell Block, and former PBD employees Richard Fielding, Michae Legault, and Cecilia Sevilla, alleging causes of action, including racial discrimination, retaliation, excessive force, and unlawful arrest;

WHEREAS, Plaintiff Riles has agreed to resolve his claims against the City of Oakland and the individual defendants for a settlement payment of \$360,000.00;

WHEREAS, the City does not admit any wrongdoing, liability, or any of Plaintiff Riles' allegations and has considered all the evidence, litigation costs, and litigation risks in this case; now, therefore, be it

**RESOLVED:** That the City Attorney is authorized and directed to compromise and settle the claims of Plaintiff Riles against the City and the individual co-defendants in the case of Wilson Riles, Jr. v. City of Oakland, Officer Jorge Yauger, Officer Bryant Ocampo, Michael [sic] Legault, Richard Fielding, Traci Campbell Block, Cecilia Sevilla, Officer Jonathan Low,

Officer Alexandra Lowe, and DOES 5 through 10, United States District Court, Northern District of California, Case No. 3:20-cv-06869-JCS, City Attorney Matter No. 33973 for the sum of Three Hundred Sixty Thousand Dollars and Zero Cents (\$360,000.00); and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Attorney is further authorized and directed to take whatever steps as may be necessary to effect said settlement.
