RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO NEGOTIATE AND EXECUTE A CONTRACT BETWEEN THE CITY OF OAKLAND AND RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT ASSOCIATES IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED THREE HUNDEDRED AND FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$305,000) ANNUALLY FOR OUTCOME AND PROCESS EVALUTION SERVICES FOR MEASURE Y VIOLENCE PREVENTION AND COMMUNITY POLICING PROGRAMS WITH TWO ONE-YEAR OPTIONS TO RENEW FOR THE FY 2012-15 FUNDING CYCLES.

WHEREAS, City of Oakland voters passed Measure Y – the Violence Prevention and Public Safety Act of 2004 – to provide tax revenue each year for ten years to support violence prevention and community policing programs and services in Oakland; and

WHEREAS, the Violence Prevention and Public Safety Act of 2004 stipulates that not less that 1% or more than 3% of funds appropriated to any police or social service programs shall be set aside for the purpose of an annual independent evaluation of the programs, including the number of people served and the rate of crime or violence reduction achieved; and

WHEREAS, the Violence Prevention and Public safety Act of 2004 stipulates that the violence prevention and community policing programs shall be evaluated annually; and

WHEREAS, City staff developed and disseminated a Request for Proposals in August 2012 and conducted a review process to identify a contractor to provide evaluation services; and

WHEREAS, the selected contractor, Resource Development Associates was ranked first in the competitive bidding process and has a clear understanding of Measure Y programs and strategies, has the breadth of experience, and range of content knowledge and technical capacity; and

WHEREAS, the City Administrator wishes to enter into a one-year contractual agreement, with two one-year options for renewal, with Resource Development Associates to provide an outcome and process evaluation of the Measure Y programs during the FY 2012-13, 2013-14, and 2014-15 funding cycles; and now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, The funds will be made available for an outcome and process evaluation of Measure Y programs, and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the City Administrator or her designee is hereby authorized to negotiate and execute a contract with Resource Development Associates in an amount not to exceed three hundred five thousand dollars (\$305,000) annually to provide an outcome and process evaluation for the Measure Y violence prevention and community policing programs; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the City Administrator is hereby authorized to conduct all negotiations, execute and submit all documents, including but not limited to applications, agreements, amendments, modification, payment requests and related actions which may be necessary in accordance with its basic purpose, at no additional contract costs; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Administrator is hereby authorized to execute the two one-year options to renew the contract with Resource Development Associates without further City Council approval; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That said agreements shall be approved as to form and legality by the Office of the City Attorney and placed on file in the Office of the City Clerk.
