WHEREAS, Oakland Renaissance NMTC, Inc., will be applying for an allocation of New Market Tax Credits from the Department of the Treasury in the 2005 NMTC round; and

WHEREAS, a central mission of the City of Oakland is to support economic development and job creation in its low-income communities; now, therefore, be it
