

RESOLUTION No. 88756 C.M.S.

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR OR DESIGNEE TO APPLY FOR, ACCEPT, AND APPROPRIATE GRANT FUNDS FROM THE BAY AREA AIR QUALITY MANAGEMENT DISTRICT FOR THE COMMERCIAL LAWN AND GARDEN PROJECT IN AN AMOUNT NOT-TO-EXCEED NINETY-TWO THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$92,000.00).

WHEREAS, the City of Oakland Public Works Department, Parks and Tree Services Division is responsible for maintenance of City Parks, and

WHEREAS, Parks and Tree Services Division uses gas-powered equipment in landscape maintenance activities; and

WHEREAS, Parks and Tree Services Division seeks to improve its operations to be more efficient and sustainable; and

WHEREAS, the City of Oakland established a grant prioritization list on as needed basis to serve as the implementation plan for funding opportunities and pursue grant funded projects; and

WHEREAS, Bay Area Quality Management District has been delegated the responsibility for the administration of Commercial Lawn and Garden Equipment Project, setting up necessary procedures governing the application; and

WHEREAS, said procedures established by the Bay Area Quality Management District require the Applicant to certify by resolution the approval of application before submission of said application to the District; and

WHEREAS, successful Applicants will enter into a contract with the Bay Area Quality Management District to complete a Zero Emission Project; now therefore, be it

RESOLVED: That the City Council approves the filing of an application for the City of Oakland Zero Emission Project.

1. Certifies that said Applicant has or will have available, prior to commencement of any work on the project included in this application, the sufficient funds to complete the project; and
2. Certifies that if the project is awarded the Applicant has or will have sufficient funds to operate and maintain the project, and

3. Certifies that the Applicant has reviewed, understands, and agrees to the General Provisions contained in the contract shown in the Grant Administration Guide; and
4. Authorizes the City Administrator, or designee, to conduct all negotiations, sign and submit all documents, including, but not limited to applications, agreements, amendments, and payment requests, which may be necessary for the completion of the Grant Scope; and
5. Agrees to comply with all applicable federal, state and local laws, ordinances, rules, regulations and guidelines.

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Administrator or Designee is hereby authorized to accept and appropriate funds in an amount not to exceed \$92,000 from the Bay Area Air Quality Management District. Funds will be appropriated in the Bay Area Air Quality Management District Fund (2166); Parks and Tree Services: Park Services Org (30652); Park Maintenance Program (NB07), in a Project and Account to be determined; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That a copy of this resolution shall be filed with the City Clerk.


