RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO AWARD A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$370,000 TO THE LOWEST RESPONSIVE BIDDER FOR THE SAFE ROUTES TO SCHOOL SECOND CYCLE PROJECT (CITY PROJECT NO. G219210, FEDERAL PROJECT NO. STPLHSR-5012(063)), WITHOUT RETURN TO COUNCIL

WHEREAS, the Safe Routes to School Second Cycle Project is a federally funded project which is consistent with the City Council Budget Priorities of **Clean and Livable Communities** and **Renewed Infrastructure**; and

WHEREAS, the construction contract for the Safe Routes to School Second Cycle Project consists of the installation of a new traffic signal at the intersection of Bancroft Avenue/77th Avenue, new curb bulb-outs at the intersection of Fruitvale Avenue/East 16th Street (North), and new curb bulb-outs at one mid-block location on Grand Avenue between Weldon and Sunnyslope Avenues; and

WHEREAS, the City will advertise and solicit competitive bids for this project and will select and award the contract to the lowest responsive bidder in accordance with City requirements for construction contracts; and

WHEREAS, there are sufficient funds available from the Safe Routes to School Second Cycle State Grant Funds, Fund Number 2140, Project Number G219210; and Measure B Sales Tax Funds, Fund Number 2211, Project Number G219230 for the contract work; and

WHEREAS, the City lacks the equipment and qualified personnel to perform the necessary work; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds and determines that the performance of this contract is in the public interest because of economy; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that services under this contract will be temporary; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds and determines that the performance of this contract shall not result in the loss of employment or salary by any person having permanent status in the competitive services; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED: That the City Manager is authorized to award a construction contract in an amount not to exceed \$370,000 to the lowest responsive bidder for the Safe Routes to School

Second Cycle Project (City Project No. G219210, Federal Project No. STPLHSR-5012(063)), without return to Council; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the plans and specifications prepared by the Director of Public Works for this project are hereby approved; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the amount of the bond for faithful performance equal to the bid amount, and the amount for a bond to guarantee payment of all claims for labor and materials furnished and for the amount due under the Unemployment Insurance Act, equal to the bid amount, with respect to such work are hereby approved; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute any amendments or modifications to said contract; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the contract shall be reviewed and approved by the City Attorney and placed on file in the Office of the City Clerk; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the approval of this Resolution requires a two-thirds vote of the Council members.


