### Dear Councilmembers:

This brief report responds to concerns raised by the public and members of the Council on the installation of "whistle tip" mufflers on vehicles, and the resulting noise pollution in Oakland neighborhoods.

A "whistle tip" is a device applied to the end of a vehicle's tailpipe that makes the vehicle emit a piercing, high-pitched shriek when driven. It is thought that the first appliances were homemade devices made by driveway mechanics working on their own vehicles. Now, several local muffler shops carry a wide variety of styles. They are relatively cheap (\$50 – 80) and can be installed in 10 – 20 minutes. The installation and use of these devices constitute a violation of several sections of the California Vehicle Code: CA Vehicle Code §27150, CA Vehicle Code §27150.1, CA Vehicle Code §27151, and CA Vehicle Code §24005.

The "whistle tip" devices also violate sections of Title 8, Chapter 8.18 – NUISANCES, of the Oakland Municipal Code (OMC). We are requesting that the City Council urge the assembly to pass AB 377 in order to assist us with our effort to stop the unnecessary noise pollution and disturbances that these "Whistle Tip Mufflers" cause.
