A RESOLUTION RECOGNIZING SANDRA STEEN FOR 22 YEARS OF DISTINGUISHED SERVICE TO THE CITY OF OAKLAND

WHEREAS Sandra Steen has aired in two KTOP documentary films, including "Doing the Green Thing" and "Creeks Are a Living Thing"; and

WHEREAS Sandra Steen has organized and supported four Keep Oakland Beautiful litter index surveys; and
