Ordinance Amending Ordinance Number 12676 C.M.S. (Master Fee Schedule),

as Amended, to Establish, Modify, and Delete Fees Assessed by Selected Offices,

Departments, and Agencies of the City of Oakland

Summary

The attached ordinance amends Ordinance Number 12676 C.M.S. (the FY 2005-06 Master Fee Schedule, or "MFS"), to establish, modify and delete fees and penalties assessed by the following agencies or departments: Office of the City Council, Office of the City Administrator, Office of the City Attorney, Office of the City Clerk, Community and Economic Development Agency, Finance and Management Agency, Fire Services Agency, Office of Parks and Recreation, Police Services Agency, and Public Works Agency. In most cases, changes to fees are required to offset increases in costs related to the provision of services for which fees are charged. In areas where fee comparisons are applicable, the City of Oakland's fees are similar to other neighboring jurisdictions. Detailed explanations/justifications for fee changes are provided in the "Discussion" section below.

A public hearing has been scheduled to review the proposed fee changes. The meeting will take place at the time of the first reading of the proposed ordinance by the City Council, on June 8, 2006, at 5:00 pm or as soon as practically possible thereafter.

Fiscal Impact

The revenue from the proposed changes in fees will produce an estimated \$0.53 million over the amount projected in the FY 2005-07 Adopted Policy Budget. Of this amount, \$0.27 million will accrue to Fund 1010 (General Purpose Fund) and \$0.26 million will accrue to Fund 2417 (Excess Litter Fee Fund). The anticipated additional revenue will help offset increases in costs to provide services for which the increased fees are charged, with no net gain. Both revenue and cost increases have already been anticipated in the proposed FY 2006-07 Midcycle budget adjustment.

Discussion

The following attachments are presented with this agenda report.

- Attachment A shows proposed changes to the Master Fee Schedule for FY2006-07, for City Council adoption.
- Attachment B reflects changes already adopted by the City Council, but not yet reflected in the published Master Fee Schedule document, because they were approved after the

previous annual document (FY 2005-06) had been published. Examples of such changes include corrections to CEDA's Residential Rent Adjustment fee and Workforce Development fee.

The Master Fee Schedule changes not yet approved by the City Council, and presented in Attachment A, are summarized below, along with justifications and estimated revenue changes.

1. City Council

• The City Council has proposed to <u>delete</u> its fees for Council district handbook as these handbooks are no longer available.

2. Office of the City Administrator – Marketing

- KTOP is proposing to <u>increase</u> its production services fees to offset rising costs of providing services.
- In addition, KTOP is proposing to <u>reduce</u> certain fees based upon a recent analysis and <u>eliminate</u> those fees which are no longer applicable.
- No changes in overall revenues are anticipated from the above fee modifications because in addition to increasing some fees, KTOP has also deleted and reduced some fees. Overall, the fee increases in some areas will be offset by the deletion and reduction of fees in other areas.

3. City Attorney

- The Office of the City Attorney has proposed to <u>increase</u> its fees to reflect increased costs to provide services (due to MOU agreements and changes in the fringe benefit rate). In addition, rates were not updated in the FY05-06 Master Fee Schedule.
- The revenue increase of approximately \$10,000 was anticipated and included in the FY 2005-07 Adopted Policy budget.

4. City Clerk

- The City Clerk has proposed to <u>increase</u> its fee for subscribing to the Large Agenda Packet to help offset the actual costs of providing service.
- The estimated annual revenue of \$27,097 will accrue to Fund 1010 (General Purpose Fund), and has been included in the Proposed FY 2006-07 Midcycle Amended budget.

5. Finance and Management Agency

 The Finance and Management Agency (FMA) has proposed to <u>increase</u> its fee for onstreet parking meter in all areas except the central business district to \$1.25 per hour. The revenue increase of approximately \$600,000 was anticipated and included in the FY 2005-07 Adopted Policy budget. • In addition, FMA proposed to add a <u>new</u> fee for excess litter per adoption of Council Ordinance number 12727 C.M.S., February 21, 2006. The estimated annual revenue of \$266,000 will accrue to Fund 2417 (Excess Litter Fee Fund), and has been included in the FY 2006-07 Proposed Midcycle Amended budget.

6. Police Services

- The Police Services Agency (PSA) has proposed to <u>increase</u> the following fees: i) dog license fees; ii) penalty fee for failure to renew a dog license within 30 days; iii) redemption fee for claiming an impounded animal; iv) service fee for confining, isolating and observing animal showing symptoms of rabies; v) maximum purchase fee for any animal; vi) service fee for disposal of dead animals; vii) vehicle release fees; viii) fee for signs containing visual and verbal warning; ix) fee to neuter/spay dogs or cats; x) a penalty fee for a 2nd inspection to enforce the Dangerous Dog ordinance; and xi) fees for the animal shelter's medical procedures. The fee increases will help to offset rising costs of providing services.
- The PSA has proposed to add the following new fees: i) fee to neuter/spay a male cat/dog for a licensed not for profit rescue group; ii) fee for animal shelter medical procedures; iii) a multiple dog fee per the passage of OMC Section 6.-04.400; and iv) pet supplies. The new fees are proposed to help offset the actual costs of providing services.
- The estimated additional revenue of \$16,325 will accrue to Fund 1010 (General Purpose Fund) and has been included in the Proposed FY 2006-07 Midcycle Amended budget.
- The PSA also proposed to <u>delete</u> various fees and <u>revise descriptions</u> to better reflect the actual services performed. No revenue loss is anticipated from the deletions, as they are no longer applicable.

7. Fire Services

- The Fire Services Agency (FSA) has proposed to <u>increase</u> its fees by an average of five percent across the board, to reflect increased costs to provide services (driven by CPI and MOU increases).
- The FSA has also proposed to add <u>new fees</u> under High-Rise Inspections. The new fees are proposed in order to reflect the actual services performed and help offset the actual costs of providing such services.
- The revenue increase of approximately \$84,000 was anticipated and included in the FY 2005-07 Adopted Policy budget.

8. Office of Parks and Recreation

• The Office of Parks and Recreation (OPR) has proposed to <u>increase</u> family camp fees, fees for cultural arts classes in Studio One and golfing fees. The fee increases will help to offset rising costs of providing services and bring them in line with other jurisdictions.

- OPR has proposed to add the following new fees: i) Laser Sailing Club Pass Card; ii) Tallship Adventure Sail; iii) After School Sailing; iv) Tallship/Sailing Camp; and v) Advanced Keelboat Camp @ Estuary. The new fees are proposed to help offset the actual costs of providing services.
- OPR has also proposed to <u>delete</u> the weekly rate fee for chartered bus travel and meal charges for staff spouse/dependent and wrangler, as they are no longer applicable.
- In addition, OPR has also reduced some of its golfing fees to bring them in line with other jurisdictions.
- No significant changes in overall OPR revenues are anticipated from the above fee
 modifications because in addition to increasing some fees, OPR has also deleted and
 reduced some fees. Overall, the fee increases in some areas will be offset by the
 deletion and reduction of fees in other areas.

9. Public Works

- The Public Works Agency (PWA) has proposed to <u>increase</u> its Mailing Surcharge fee to offset actual cost of sending documents using US Priority Mail "Flat Rate."
- PWA has also proposed several <u>new fees</u>: i) fee for undergrounding engineering services; ii) cross street banner installation/removal fee; iii) fee to repair damage to City of Oakland streetlight and traffic signal equipment; iv) fee for an electrical engineering review; and v) credit card processing fee. The new fees will offset the actual costs of providing services.
- In addition, PWA has <u>revised</u> some of its fee descriptions to better reflect the actual services performed.
- Lastly, at the direction of the Public Works Committee in March 2006, Public Works and Finance and Management Agency staffs have analyzed the annual costs of the Residential Permit Parking program and determined that the permit fee would need to be set at \$65 per year in order to be fully cost-covering. The fully cost-covering rate represents a 100 to 333% increase since the fees have not been adjusted since inception of the program in 1986. The City may opt to implement the fee increase over several years. The estimated additional revenue of \$145,114 will accrue to Fund 1010 (General Purpose Fund).

10. Community and Economic Development Agency

- The Community and Economic Development Agency (CEDA) has proposed to <u>increase</u> most of its fees by an average of four percent to reflect increased costs to provide services.
- CEDA has proposed to add the following <u>new</u> fees: i) fees to process billing appeals with referral to collections; ii) fees to process billing appeals for a second research/review; iii) a fee for electronic payment transactions; iv) fee for a permit record report; v) jobs/housing administrative appeal fee; and vi) fee to request a redevelopment plan. The new fees are proposed to cover the actual costs of providing development services.

- CEDA has proposed to <u>delete</u> the following fees: i) publications for uniform building, plumbing, mechanical, swimming pool/spa/hot tub, fire code and national electrical code; ii) various residential loan processing/origination/application fees; and iii) fee for a report of residential building record ("3-R" report). The fees are being deleted as they are no longer applicable.
- The estimated additional revenue of \$78,888 will accrue to fund 1010 (General Purpose Fund) and has been included in the FY 2006-07 Proposed Midcycle Amended budget.

Recommendation

Staff recommends that the City Council accept this report and adopt the proposed ordinance amending the Master Fee Schedule, as reflected in <u>Attachment A</u>. Once adopted, the amended fees will become effective on July 1, 2006. A public hearing has been scheduled to review the proposed fee changes. The meeting will take place at the time of the first reading of the proposed ordinance by the Council, on June 8, 2006, at 5:00 pm or as soon as practically possible thereafter.






