RESOLUTION HONORING DOROTHY KING TO RECOGNIZE HER YEARS OF SERVICE AS A PHILANTHROPIST, COMMUNITY ACTIVIST AND BUSINESS LEADER

WHEREAS, Dorothy King is a proud native Oaklander and the daughter of Dorothy Turner Everett who founded the popular Everett & Jones Barbeque restaurants in the East Bay; and

WHEREAS, Dorothy King restored an abandoned warehouse in Jack London Square to launch a new location for Everett & Jones which she built into a true community institution that has become one the anchors of the neighborhood; and

WHEREAS, Dorothy King is renowned for her service to the local community by nurturing the arts by creating a blues venue within the restaurant, by feeding unsheltered neighbors regularly, and by hosting countless fundraisers for charitable causes over many years; and

WHEREAS, her success as a local business leader and as a Director at the Oakland African American Chamber of Commerce has helped create jobs and economic opportunities and project a positive vision of Oakland; and

WHEREAS, Dorothy King is known throughout her community as a loving mother and grandmother, a committed civil rights leader, and an activist on the side of all disenfranchised and marginalized communities; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to publicly commended her for her decades of service in Oakland; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED: That the City Council of Oakland hereby honors Dorothy King for her years of services to the community as a philanthropist, community activist and business leader.
