RESOLUTION TO ACCEPT AND APPROPRIATE A GRANT FOR ONE HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$100,000) FROM THE FIREMAN'S FUND HERITAGE PROGRAM TO THE OAKLAND FIRE DEPARTMENT OFFICE OF EMERGENCY SERVICES FOR THE CITIZENS OF OAKLAND RESPOND TO EMERGENCIES (CORE) PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the City of Oakland and the City Council are committed to improving community emergency preparedness by providing citizens with training and skills to sustain themselves and assist family members, neighbors, coworkers and others until professional emergency personnel arrive; and

WHEREAS, the Fireman's Fund Heritage program is a national community-based program that provides equipment, fire prevention tools and firefighter training for local fire departments, as well as community fire safety education, created by Fireman's Fund Insurance Company as its long-term philanthropic mission; and

WHEREAS, the Fireman's Fund Heritage program donated \$100,000 to the City of Oakland Fire Department's Citizens of Oakland Respond to Emergencies (CORE) program to enhance promotional materials, purchase additional training equipment and supplies, and support active neighborhood CORE Teams; and

WHEREAS, the donation does not impact the City's General Fund; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: that the City Council hereby authorizes the City Administrator to accept and appropriate the Fireman's Fund Heritage program grant in the amount of \$100,000 to the Oakland Fire Department Office of Emergency Services, Fund 2190, Organization 20711, Project Number to be assigned.


