RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR, ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF OAKLAND, TO ACCEPT AND APPROPRIATE A GRANT IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED TWO HUNDRED TWENTY-FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$225,000) FROM THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE (USDOJ), OFFICE OF JUSTICE PROGRAMS, EXECUTIVE OFFICE OF WEED AND SEED FOR THE CONTINUED PROGRAM IMPLEMENTATION OF THE WEST OAKLAND WEED AND SEED INITIATIVE AND AUTHORIZING A FUNDING AGREEMENT IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED TWENTY-FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$25,000) WITH THE OAKLAND POLICE ACTIVITIES LEAGUE FOR TRUANCY AND MENTORING SERVICES ASSOCIATED WITH THE PROGRAM

WHEREAS, it is anticipated that grant funds totaling two hundred twenty-five thousand dollars (\$225,000) will be awarded by the U.S. Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs, Executive Office of Weed and Seed to the Police Department for continued implementation of the West Oakland Weed and Seed Initiative (WOWSI); and

WHEREAS, the Police Department desires to enter into a Funding Agreement with the Oakland Police Activities League (Oakland PAL) in an amount not to exceed twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) for truancy and mentoring services associated with the program, to be funded by the grant; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that the services provided pursuant to the agreement with Oakland PAL authorized hereunder are of a professional, scientific or technical nature and are temporary in nature; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds the agreement with Oakland PAL shall not result in a loss of employment or salary by any person having permanent status in the competitive service; now, therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the City Council hereby authorizes the City Administrator or her designee to accept and appropriate a grant in an amount not to exceed \$225,000 from the U.S. Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs, Executive Office of Weed and Seed to the Federal Grant Fund: 2112, Org.: 103520; Program: PS01, in a Project Account to be determined, for continued implementation of WOWSI; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Administrator or her designee is hereby authorized to enter into a Funding Agreement with Oakland PAL in an amount not to exceed \$25,000 for truancy and mentoring services associated with the program, and funded by the grant; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Council hereby appoints the City Administrator as agent of the City to conduct all negotiations, applications, agreements, and related actions which may be necessary for the completion of the aforementioned grant and funding agreements; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Attorney shall review and approve said agreement with Oakland PAL and a copy of the fully executed agreement shall be placed on file with the Office of the City Clerk.
