Supplemental Report Regarding the Resolution Confirming Locations for Previously Approved New Meters as Required by Oakland Municipal Code

Section 10.36.141

SUMMARY

At its June 24, 2010 meeting, the City Council directed staff to install new parking meters citywide to generate additional revenue, which was budgeted at \$267,000 annually. Staff has identified locations for the new parking meters based on their proximity to commercial businesses. While the City Council was previously informed of the zones within which the new meters would be placed, Oakland Municipal Code Section 10.36.141 requires that the City Council approve all parking meter locations, and so they are provided here.

At the January 11, 2011 Finance & Management Committee meeting, staff was requested to reduce the recommended number of new parking meters to be installed in District 1 to no more than the percentage of any other district, which was estimated to be 25%. Staff was further requested to return with a proposal that distributes meter installations equitably citywide. This report amends staff's original recommendations to reflect the reduction in proposed parking meters for District 1. Fulfillment of the budgeted amount of 250 meters will require that staff return with a recommendation for an additional 21 meters.

FISCAL IMPACT

The new meters are budgeted to generate additional annual revenue of \$267,000 beginning in fiscal year 2010-11. These revenues will be deposited in the General Purpose Fund (1010), Treasury: Operations (08721), Parking Fee: On Street Parking Meters Account (21317), and Financial Management Program (IP59).

BACKGROUND

At its June 24, 2010 meeting, the City Council directed staff to install new parking meters citywide to generate additional revenue. After selection of meter locations, and informing the Council via memorandum, installation of 298 parking meters began in

September 2010. As of **D**ecember 16, 2010, 92 parking meters have been installed. Although staff has informed the City Council of the parking meter zones, Section 10.36.141 of the Oakland Municipal Code further requires that City Council pass a resolution approving all parking meter locations.

DISCUSSION

The following table is a partial recommendation for the new meter installations requested. Staff will return to Council with a recommendation for an additional 21 meters.


