RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO ENTER INTO A GRANT AGREEMENT WITH THE CHILD ABUSE LISTENING, INTERVIEWING, AND COORDINATION CENTER (CALICO) IN THE AMOUNT OF TWENTY-FOUR THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED NINETY-NINE DOLLARS (\$24,999) FOR THE PERIOD OF JULY 1, 2008 THROUGH JUNE 30, 2009, TO PROVIDE FORENSIC INTERVIEWS, MULTI-DISCIPLINARY CHILD ABUSE INVESTIGATIONS, FAMILY SUPPORT SERVICES, COMMUNITY OUTREACH, AND TRAINING TO THE OAKLAND POLICE DEPARTMENT

WHEREAS, the Child Abuse, Listening, Interviewing, and Coordination Center (CALICO) is an accredited child advocacy center (the only one serving Alameda County) with its main facility in San Leandro, and a satellite office at the Alameda County's Family Justice Center in Oakland; and

WHEREAS, CALICO plays an integral part in the Oakland Police Department's efforts to combat child abuse by minimizing the trauma to abused children, by improving coordination of child abuse case investigations, and supporting children and their families in receiving appropriate medical, legal, and therapeutic services; and

WHEREAS, during the period of January 1, 2008 through December 15, 2008, CALICO interviewed 676 children and developmentally delayed adults; 141 or 20.8% of those youth and adults being Oakland residents; and

WHEREAS, a grant agreement for services provided by CALICO to the Oakland Police Department in an amount not to exceed \$24,999 will support CALICO's annual operating budget of \$750,000; and

WHEREAS, funds in the amount of \$24,999 have been identified in the Federal Asset Forfeiture Fund (2910), the Office of the Chief of Police Organization (101110), Miscellaneous Services Account (53719), Federal Asset Forfeiture Project (H76020), Agency-wide Administration Program (PS01); now, therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the Oakland City Council does hereby authorize the City Administrator, on behalf of the City of Oakland's Police Department, to enter into a grant agreement with CALICO, in an amount not to exceed \$24,999 to provide forensic interviews, multi-disciplinary child abuse investigations, family support services, community outreach and training to the Oakland Police Department for the period of July 1, 2008 through June 30, 2009.
