Resolution Authorizing Award Of A Contract To Andes Construction, Inc. For The Rehabilitation Of Sanitary Sewers In The Area Bounded By Telegraph Avenue, 24Th Street, Lee Street, Harrison Street And 20Th Street – Part One Sub-basin 52-05 (Project No. C227210) For The Amount Of Four Million Three Hundred Fifteen Thousand Five Hundred Thirty-Six Dollars (\$4,315,536.00)

SUMMARY

A resolution has been prepared authorizing the City Administrator to award a construction contract in the amount of \$4,315,536.00 to Andes Construction, Inc. for the Rehabilitation of Sanitary Sewers in the area bounded by Telegraph Avenue, 24th Street, Lee Street, Harrison Street and 20th Street – part one Sub-basin 52-05 (Project No. C227210). The work to be completed under this project is part of the City's annual Sanitary Sewer Infiltration/Inflow (I/I) Correction Program and 100% of the work will be performed by Small Local Business Enterprises. The work is located in Council District 3 and as shown on the location map in *Attachment A*.

It is recommended that the resolution be approved.

FISCAL IMPACT

There are sufficient funds in the project budget for the work. These funds are available in the Sewer Service Fund (3100); Capital Project-Sanitary Sewer Design Organization (92244); Sewers Account (57417); Project No. C227210.

BACKGROUND

On October 23, 2006, the City Clerk received one bid for this project in the amount of \$4,315,536.00 as shown in *Attachment B*. The Engineer's Estimate for this work is \$4,329,000.00. The bidder, Andes Construction, Inc., is deemed responsive and responsible, and therefore is recommended for the award.

This project will rehabilitate and upgrade the sanitary sewer pipes within the project area, eliminate the infiltration of rain and ground water into the sanitary sewers system, and limit

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overflows and backups during wet weather. This project meets the Mayor/Council Goals and Citywide Objective to **Build Community and Foster Livable Neighborhoods** by providing for clean, well-maintained sanitary sewer systems.

In general, the proposed work consists of rehabilitating approximately 30,350 linear feet of existing sewer pipes ranging in diameter size from 6" to 24", and other related work as indicated on the plans and specifications.

Under the proposed contract with Andes Construction, Inc., SLBE participation of \$4,315,536.00 (100%) exceeds the City's 20% LBE/SLBE requirement. The contractor shows \$30,000.00 (100%) for trucking exceeding the 20% Local Trucking requirement. The contractor received 5% credit for LBE/SLBE preference, or \$215,776.80, that made the adjusted bid amount \$4,099,759.20. The contractor is required to have 50% of the work hours performed by Oakland residents, and 50% of all new hires are to be Oakland residents. The LBE/SLBE information has been verified by the Contract Compliance Division of the City Administrator's Office and is shown in *Attachment B*.

KEY ISSUES AND IMPACTS

Construction is scheduled to begin in April 2007 and should be completed by May 2008. The contract specifies \$1,000.00 in liquidated damages per working day if the contract is not completed within 280 working days. The project schedule is shown in *Attachment C*.

SUSTAINABLE OPPORTUNITIES

<u>Economic:</u> The contractor is required to have 50% of the work hours performed by Oakland residents, and 50% of all new hires are to be Oakland residents.

<u>Environmental</u>: The City's I/I Correction Program reduces the incidence of sewer overflows and thus prevents potential harm to water resources and the bay. The contractor will be required to make every effort to reuse clean fill materials and use recyclable concrete and asphalt products. Best Management Practices for the protection of storm water runoff during construction will be required.

<u>Social Equity:</u> This project is part of the citywide program to eliminate wastewater overflows thereby benefiting all Oakland residents.

DISABILITY AND SENIOR CITIZEN ACCESS

There is no direct impact or benefit to seniors or people with disabilities.

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RECOMMENDATION AND RATIONALE

It is recommended that the construction contract be awarded to Andes Construction Inc., the responsible bidder, in the amount of \$4,315,536.00 for The Rehabilitation of Sanitary Sewers in the area bounded by Telegraph Avenue, 24th Street, Lee Street, Harrison Street and 20th Street – part one Sub-basin 52-05 (Project No. C227210). Andes Construction, Inc. has met the LBE/SLBE requirements, and there are sufficient funds in the project account.

ACTION REQUESTED OF THE CITY COUNCIL

Staff recommends that the City Council approve the resolution.




