INTRODUCED BY COUNCILMEMBER PAT KERNIGHAN

Allocation of \$1,500 of Councilmember Pat Kernighan's Priority Purpose Funds to the Oakland, California Babe Ruth League for Expenses Associated with Two Team Members of the All Star Team Participating in a 2008 College Tour

WHEREAS, On June 8, 2006 the City Council did amend the 2005-2007 Policy Budget for the City of Oakland to include \$250,000 apiece for each Councilmember to use as Priority Purpose Funds for projects at each councilmember's discretion but subject to City Council approval; and

WHEREAS, The All Star Team of the Oakland, California Babe Ruth League, a 501(C)3 organization, targets 14 and 15 year old at-risk youth from throughout Oakland, and provides them with a quality athletic program that emphasizes the importance of a college education and community service.

WHEREAS, The All Star Team combines travel baseball with the promise to introduce inner-city youth to life on various college and university campuses.

WHEREAS, The All Star Team will make a campus tour of Morehouse College and Florida A& M University in the Fall of 2008 to become familiar with the academic, athletic and social aspects of these institutions of higher learning; and to participate in the Disney Wide World of Sports Tournament in Orlando, Florida.

RESOLVED: That \$1,500 of Councilmember Pat Kernighan's Priority Purpose Funds be apportioned to the Oakland, California Babe Ruth League for expenses of the All Star Team related to two of its team members participating in the Fall 2008 College Tour.
