ORDINANCE (1) AUTHORIZING A LICENSE AGREEMENT WITH OAKLAND PARKS AND RECREATION FOUNDATION FOR USE OF OFFICE SPACE AT THE LAKESIDE PARK GARDEN CENTER LOCATED AT 666 BELLEVUE AVENUE AT THE BELOW MARKET RATE OF \$0.00 THROUGH JUNE 30, 2026, WITH A 3-YEAR OPTION TO RENEW; (2) MAKING FINDINGS THAT THE LICENSE FOR BELOW FAIR MARKET VALUE IS IN THE BEST INTEREST OF THE CITY; AND (3) MAKING APPROPRIATE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT (CEQA) FINDINGS

This Ordinance would authorize a license agreement with Oakland Parks and Recreation Foundation for use of office space at the Lakeside Park Garden Center (Marsha J. Corprew Memorial) at the below market rate of Zero Dollars (\$0.00) through June 30, 2026, with a 3-year option to renew, in return for certain in-kind services, and makes appropriate California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) findings
