

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO AMEND A PROFESSIONAL SERVICES CONTRACT WITH THE SPANISH SPEAKING UNITY COUNCIL TO ADD DESIGN WORK FOR THE UNION POINT PARK PROJECT FOR A TOTAL CONTRACT AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED ONE HUNDRED FORTY-NINE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED TWENTY DOLLARS (\$149,920)

WHEREAS, The City of Oakland (City) leased a nine-acre property from the Port of Oakland located in Oakland known as Union Point Park site; and

WHEREAS, The City and the Spanish Speaking Unity Council desire to develop improvements to the nine-acre site in accordance with the adopted Master Plan for Union Point Park; and

WHEREAS, the City Council authorized the City Manager to execute a professional services agreement with the Spanish Speaking Unity Council in October 2000 to begin preliminary development work for the project to be funded by grants obtained by the Spanish Speaking Unity Council; and

WHEREAS, the California State Coastal Conservancy has made available to the Spanish Speaking Unity Council \$1.5 million dollars for the development and construction of the Union Point Park project; and

WHEREAS, \$1.419 million in State of California Department of Parks and Recreation Murray Hayden Urban Parks and Youth Services Program and \$1.040 million from Measure K, Series D is designated for the City of Oakland to fund Phase I and part of Phase II of the Park's development; and

WHEREAS, the implementation of the Union Point Park Master Plan project would benefit the City and the Oakland community at large; and

WHEREAS, the City wishes to amend the existing agreement with Spanish Speaking Unity Council to add design work for the project, for an amount not-to-exceed one hundred forty nine thousand nine hundred twenty dollars, to be funded by grants obtained by the City; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds and determines that the services provided under this contract are professional and temporary in nature; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds and determines that the performance of this contract shall not result in the loss of employment or salary by any person having permanent status in the competitive services; now therefore, be it

RESOLVED: That the City Manager, or his designee, is hereby authorized to amend the professional services agreement with Spanish Speaking Unity Council to provide design services for development of the Union Point Park for a total contract amount not to exceed one hundred forty nine thousand nine hundred twenty dollars (\$149,920); and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Manager, or his designated representative, is hereby authorized to approve any subsequent amendments, modifications, or extensions of said agreement, excepting those related to increasing the amount of the contract above the amounts authorized under this Resolution; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That all documents shall be reviewed and approved by City Attorney for form and legality prior to execution, and copies will be placed on file with the City Clerk.
