RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY ATTORNEY TO COMPROMISE AND SETTLE THE CASE OF REBECCA JOHNSON V. CITY OF OAKLAND, AND DOES 1-20, INCLUSIVE, ALAMEDA COUNTY SUPERIOR COURT CASE NO. 21CV004044, CITY ATTORNEY'S FILE NO. 34576, IN THE AMOUNT OF ONE HUNDRED SEVENTY FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS AND NO CENTS (\$175,000.00) (DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION – DANGEROUS CONDITION OF PUBLIC PROPERTY)

WHEREAS, Plaintiff Rebecca Johnson (“Johnson”) allegedly tripped and fell on an uplifted portion of sidewalk on Bay Place near Grand Avenue on October 22, 2020; and

WHEREAS, Johnson sustained a right femur fracture as a result of the trip and fall; and

WHEREAS, Johnson filed *Rebecca Johnson v. City of Oakland, et al.*, Alameda County Superior Court Case No. 21CV004044 against the City of Oakland alleging a claim for dangerous condition of public property, and claiming past medical expenses, loss of income, and pain and suffering; and

WHEREAS, without admitting fault or wrongdoing, the City has determined to compromise Johnson’s claim for the sum of One Hundred Seventy-Five Thousand Dollars and no Cents (\$175,000.00); now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED: That the City Attorney is authorized and directed to compromise and settle the case of *Rebecca Johnson v. City of Oakland, et al.*, Alameda County Superior Court Case No. 21CV004044, City Attorney’s File No. 34576 for the sum of One Hundred Seventy Five Thousand Dollars and No Cents (\$175,000.00); and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Attorney is further authorized and directed to take whatever steps as may be necessary to effect said settlement.
