Jul/Aug/Sept 2004, Monthly Accounts and Oct/Nov/Dec 2004, Quarterly Accounts

SUMMARY

On February 22, 2005, pursuant to Chapter 8.28, of the Oakland Municipal Code, an administrative hearing was held to hear protests and resolve any inconsistencies or inequities prior to the public hearing before the City Council. Each affected property owner was notified of the administrative hearing. Accordingly, nine cases were resolved and removed from the list of delinquent properties. A resolution has been prepared confirming the placement of liens on 6,669 accounts and authorizing the subsequent assessment for all fees and charges, should they remain unpaid at the time of submission to the County Assessor.

FISCAL IMPACT

Waste Management of Alameda County has billed the City \$1,420,540 which represents monthly charges for July through September 2004 and quarterly charges for October through December 2004. The bill becomes payable after the public hearing is held. Property owners owe the City delinquent garbage charges and administrative fees totaling \$1,819,787 for this period. The City will transfer these charges to the Alameda County Tax Rolls to avoid a \$1,420,540 charge to the General Fund.

BACKGROUND

The public hearing represents monthly billings for July through September 2004 and quarterly billings for October through December 2004.
