**A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING A
\$25,000 CONTRIBUTION FROM THE REDEVELOPMENT
AGENCY UNDER THE COOPERATION AGREEMENT
FOR THE SAN ANTONIO HILLS HISTORIC PROPERTIES
AND EDUCATIONAL PROGRAM**

WHEREAS, the San Antonio Hills Historic Properties and Educational Program (the “Program”) is a planning and educational program with the goal to preserve and rehabilitate historic properties in the EastLake/San Antonio subarea of the Central City East Redevelopment Project Area; and

WHEREAS, the staff of the Community and Economic Development Agency is prepared to undertake an assessment of properties in the EastLake/San Antonio subarea of the Central City East Redevelopment Project Area; and

WHEREAS, the City and the Agency entered in a Cooperation Agreement on July 1, 2004, which generally governs the provision of assistance and the payment of funds between the two agencies, including Redevelopment Agency financial contributions and other assistance to support improvements to the Central City East Redevelopment Property Area; and

WHEREAS, the Program will assist property owners with the rehabilitation of their property in the Central City East Project Area by providing them with educational information and materials to address blighted properties and properties in need of repair; and

WHEREAS, the Agency has authorized a contribution of \$25,000 to the City from Redevelopment Agency funds for the Program; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED: That the City Council hereby accepts and appropriates a \$25,000 contribution from the Redevelopment Agency under the Cooperation Agreement for the Program, to the City of Oakland’s Planning Department Fund (7780), Major Projects Organization (88211), and Project Number to be determined; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Administrator, or her designee, is hereby authorized to conduct negotiations, execute documents, and take any other actions with respect to the Program consistent with this Resolution and its basic purpose.


